



YiA Training for youth leaders, Dinard, château Hébert, France, 5-11 April 2014

Background Information

The LLL strategy aims at providing the necessary competences to people for being able to adapt to a changing world where new challenges may arise and new approaches are required to face them. Everyone is therefore called to be a learner and a leader able to see the changes and to identify the necessary competences to acquire or to perform in the new given situations. There are course about learning, management and leadership techniques that can partly answer the above mentioned needs. The TC Le.Le. will address learning as a non linear process and leadership as generative attitude as the two cannot be dissociated. It belongs to the domain of personal development through an inner quest of leadership. It rests on a mix of educational approaches that have successfully been experimented by ALP and L'Ydille Lang in the past year with a wide audience of young adults active in different sphere of society.

Aim and Objectives

The course aims at exploring the interconnection between leadership and learning as generative engines for self development and community/youth leadership leaders.

In particular it will look at how limiting beliefs can boycott the individual attitude towards learning and on how empowering beliefs can resource the individual in his/her quest for inner creativity for leadership. It will provide an opportunity for assessing the individual leadership and learning profile through an analysis of past experiences and their impact on our views to learning and leadership. It will offer also a coached experience of going out of the comfort zone to unleash the generative power of creating rapport with the others and to afford the experience of unlearning.

As a result of their participation to the course the young adults will have identified their key questions to address in their quest for learning leadership as an ongoing non linear process.

Profile of expected participants

The training course is designed for young adults in a leading role in their communities, located in the YiA programme countries, willing to undergo an exploration of themselves as leaders, their potential and having the possibility to impact their community/organisations.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Interested applicants are requested to fill in the registration <u>form</u>. The course will start on 5th April in the evening and departure is schedule on 11.04 in the morning. Food and accommodation will be provided. 70% of travel costs will be reimbursed after the event. Tuition fees are 100 Euros per participant to be paid upon arrival. Deadline to apply: 1st March 2014. Participants' selection by the 7th March.
