Some more information about the project

The training course will be held on May 23-31, 2014 in suburbs of Kyiv for 39 youth leaders, youth workers, and active volunteers from 6 countries of the EECA region (Armenia, Azerbaijan, Georgia, Belarus, Moldova, Ukraine) and 6 programme countries (Lithuania, Italy, Czech Republic, Germany, Malta, Poland). The main topic of the training will be prevention of bullying.





Main objectives:

-to raise young people's awareness about the problem of bullying in our world, the importance of joint efforts in tackling this issue, and the dramatic differences in the understanding of bullying in various countries and cultures;

-to share current work practices currently taking place, who is doing it, and who is benefiting;

-to allow participants to hear about the best practices and successes in current antibullying work;

-to empower young people in spreading the word on bullying among youngsters using non-formal educational activities;

-and to provide participants with knowledge, skills, and confidence in the area of nonformal education, techniques, and messaging;

-to develop tools which would make the concept of anti-bullying attractive, cool, and fun to follow for youngsters;

-to enable young people to develop their own educational modules which they will in turn bring to their local communities and implement with youngsters living in rural and/or deprived urban areas;

-to build up a network of anti-bullying messengers which would allow participants to support each other.

After the training, participants will implement and evaluate non-formal education activities on the topic of bullying prevention in their countries.

Bullying is a problem experienced all over the entire world, including Ukraine. Ridicule, mockery, and bullying all restrict the emotional well-being and safety of children, young people. Without effective tools and teaching materials and ambassadors it is difficult for society to deal with these issues and difficult for people to learn. If a community consists of aware, considerate, caring citizens, then it becomes more safe and secure. When communities are safe and secure, communication, education, democracy, and equality all flourish.

One of main objectives of this project is involving young people in anti-bullying work through methods of non-formal education while empowering them for future educational work among youngsters. This promotes youth work and participation as they will be working with young people who have fewer opportunities. All of these values are in line with what many Europeans hope for.





The YiA program, training, and sharing sessions will help participants to support social development, open up new opportunities, acquire essential competencies, promote personal development, allow intercultural & diversity learning, and encourage creative/active participation. A wide variety of educational methods will be used and the participants will have the chance to try them out during the training.

National currency and currency exchange

Ukrainian National currency is Ukrainian Hryvnia (UAH). 1 € is about 11 UAH. Euros can be exchanged at banks and special exchange shops.

Some info about Ukraine and Kyiv region



Ukraine is a country in <u>Eastern Europe</u>. It has an area of **603,628 km**², making it **the largest contiguous country** on the <u>European</u> continent. Ukraine borders the <u>Russian</u> <u>Federation</u> to the east and northeast, <u>Belarus</u> to the northwest, <u>Poland</u>, <u>Slovakia</u> and <u>Hungary</u> to the west, <u>Romania</u> and <u>Moldova</u> to the southwest, and the <u>Black Sea</u> and <u>Sea of Azov</u> to the south and southeast, respectively.



Ukraine is a <u>unitary state</u> composed of **24** <u>oblasts</u> (provinces), one <u>autonomous</u> republic (Crimea), and two cities with special status: Kiev, its capital and largest city, and <u>Sevastopol</u>, which houses the Russian <u>Black Sea Fleet</u> under a <u>leasing</u> agreement. The country is home to **46 million people**, 77.8 percent of whom are ethnic <u>Ukrainians</u>, with sizable minorities of <u>Russians</u> (17%), <u>Belarusians</u> and <u>Romanians</u>. The <u>Ukrainian language</u> is the <u>official language</u> in Ukraine. <u>Russian</u> is also widely spoken. The dominant religion in the country is <u>Eastern Orthodox Christianity</u>, which has heavily influenced <u>Ukrainian architecture</u>, <u>literature</u> and <u>music</u>.





The training will be held in the suburbs of the capital city of Ukraine - Kyiv. Kyiv is a modern city of 2.8 million inhabitants according to the official statistics. However the estimates of the population by scientists are closer to 3.2-3.5 million. Kiev is a bustling capital of Ukraine, full of beautiful architecture, museums, delicious restaurants, cozy cafes, vibrant nightlife and much more. The art and architecture of Kiev / Kyiv are world treasures. Kyiv has green beautiful river banks, parks, forests, and gardens which occupy over 50% of the city's territory making it one of the greenest cities of Ukraine.
