How do we solve travel costs:

- ♠ Travel costs will be reimbursed by bank transfer to participant's <u>personal bank account</u> <u>or organization's bank account</u>, AFTER participant provide us with ALL ORIGINAL TICKETS and required documents;
- ♠ Travel by car will be reimbursed <u>ONLY</u> with prior approval of organizers;
- Participants <u>must keep all travel documents</u> (tickets, gas bills, travel agency invoices and boarding passes) as organizers are able to make reimbursement only on the bases of presented documents.
