About the project

Dear participants, dear partners,

hereby we present you all the information on our common project TC 'The Change Makers 2 – Sustainable Development through Entrepreneurship Education" which will take place in Sajan, SERBIA from 11th to 18th of May 2015.

The TC is aimed at supporting the fight against youth unemployment sustainably and solving various social problems in order to achieve a more inclusive and stainable growth in the local society.

Sustainable entrepreneurship education is offering an excellent perspective: just as business entrepreneurs change the face of business, ecopreneurs, social entrepreneurs are the agents of change in their societies, developing ideas and new approaches in dealing with the issues of education, inclusion, environmental awareness, new policy development etc., all leading to changing the lives of people in their local community for the better.

The goal of the TC is to educate and prepare young people who are considering to embark on an entrepreneurial careers to address the issues related to the pillars that represent sustainable development - Economic Prosperity, Environmental Protection and Social Justice. The TC will prepare its participants for addressing these issues in their local communities innovatively and creatively.

The use of non-formal methods as inputs and discussions in plenary sessions, exercises and simulations, thematic working groups and workshops and the use of open space methodology will provide the foundation for the participants' learning processes. Emphasis will be given to the exchange of entrepreneurial and non-formal educational practices and networking among the partners and with the local community of Sajan.

The TC will include participants from Germany, Albania, Czech Republic, Romania, Italy, Macedonia, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Croatia, Serbia and Kosovo.

How to apply

The TC is designed for active youth workers, staff from youth centers, help and information centers, facilitators, trainers as well as youth representatives from business incubators to exchange their experiences.

Before you apply, make sure that you meet the following participant profil:

- to fit into the target group
- committed to set up follow-up activities after the TC
- available to attend the full TC in Serbia: May 11th May 18th, 2015
- able to communicate in English

If you meet this profile, please apply via SALTO Training Calendar until March 23rd 2014.

We will inform you about the selection results until 31st of March via e-mail or telephone in order to coordinate your travel with you.

Travel Costs

According to the rules within the Programme "Erasmus+ Youth in Action" we can give a contribution to your travel costs, on the basis of the cheapest possibilities, e.g. second class railway tickets, APEX-flights etc., accompanied by the receipt of complete and original tickets, invoices, bills, receipts, boarding cards etc. upon a certain "contribution to the travel costs of participants, from their place of origin to the venue of the activity and return". This contribution is based on the travel distance per participant. Here you find the maximum contribution to travel costs per ONE participant per country from your hometown to Sajan and back:

If possible, we are planning to pay the contribution to the travel costs to all the participants on the spot. Please make sure that your travel documents, including return trip are complete (bills, boarding passes, tickets etc.), so that we can ensure a proper payment in bar in € during the TC. In case you don't have the tickets complete we have to oblige you to send them as soon as possible after the TC to our office.



Venue and Accommodation

Our project will be realized in the European Youth Education and Meeting Centre in Sajan (https://www.facebook.com/pages/Youth-Meeting-and-Education-Centre-Sajan/1411399779125738?fref=ts). Sajan is a small village next to Kikinda. Being located in the multicultural North of Serbia, Sajan is mainly inhabited by the Hungarian minority in Serbia. See more informations here:
