Vulnerability

connecting with yourself, nature, other people, the outside world (deep ecology)

Spirituality

secret-sacred things, sharing experiences, human spirituality in different cultural backgrounds

TRAINING OBJECTIVES

- 1) To create a space for personal and professional development of youth workers, by exploring personal connections, experiences, limitations and strengths through a variety of non formal education en experiential learning methods and sharing and evaluating the experiences with other participants.
- 2) To offer participants the possibility to experience non formal education and experiential learning methods on a personal level and provide them with a practical set of non formal education and experiential learning tools, methods and activities in relation to the course topics, which they can implement and use within their local youth work.
- 3) To give an opportunity for sharing and discussing, reflection and improvement of all experienced methods. To share pedagogic and cultural aspects of youth work in different cultural realities.
- 4) To develop together new experiential and non-formal educational activities on the topics of the training course and motivate and inspire participants to work on the topic of spirituality and vulnerability in their future work.
