#### Why:

High number of IDP (Internally displaced people) in the region of Caucasus as well as Ukraine nowadays, shows urgency of answering the issue of reintegration through

Stigmatization and discrimination are following the process of integration, and this makes situation even more challenging for everyday life. In some cases it is even difficult to find specific status quo for those who had to leave their cities or who are still living near the border.
