- Identifying which behaviours are supporting your performance and interactions
- Communicating with more **clarity, accuracy and persuasiveness**
- **Expanding your capacity for creating connection (rapport) with others**
- Becoming **more conscious** of your movements on a daily basis
- Use your words and body language to **increase self-confidence**
- Rediscover the **joy of play, spontaneity and creativity**
- Gathering tools for **managing emotional states** through movement and body posture

Introducing the Routes



Expanding Routes is an 8 days training course aiming to improve the performance and communication of those who work with young people.

We will do so by focusing on 4 key aspects:

- **Communication (non-verbal, vocal and verbal)**
- **Creating and establishing connection (rapport)**
- **Creativity**
- **Personal expression**

Through **Experiential Learning** we'll provide the learning ground with different inputs and activities and we will create the space for you to reflect upon how you function in your daily working life.

We believe that this method has the unique and powerful advantage of creating a personalized learning process and more effective and long-lasting results after the training course.

The program



Day 1-4

We will work with the topics of **connection, communication, creativity, planning.**

Theoretical input together with **body movement, theater and meditations** will be the core of these days



Day 5-6

Tools and creativity in action:
2 days of **outdoor training** when you will have the opportunity to **put everything you learned into action** in a new environment.

You will spend these two days in small groups out in the Netherlands with **special assignments.**



Day 7-8

Reflection and wrapping up, closing the training together.

What happened so far?

This training course (TC) is part of a **long-term project**, and it is part of its second phase.

As a first step we had a **Study Visit in Israel** to the Neot Semadar kibbutz and the Hava ve Adam ecological educational farm. There we learned about their approach on mentoring and non-formal education through **volunteer work**.

Some of the participants of the TC also attended the study visit, and they will bring a taste of what they learned.

What will happen after the TC?

1) Follow-up Phase

After the TC there will be a **4 months implementation phase** when you will be connected online, and will actively share experience with each other. The **trainers will be available online to support you** with getting out the maximum results from what you learned and understood during the training course and/or the study visit.

2) Closing Event

To close the project there will be a **dissemination event in Hungary** where we will meet to share and spread what we learned and how we put it into action in our lives.

About the organizers

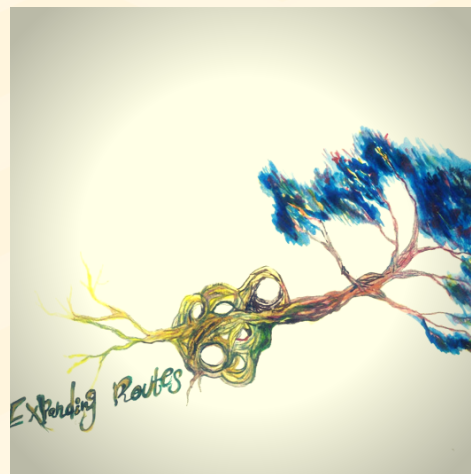


Connecting Routes is an informal group of young people from the Netherlands, Israel and Hungary.
