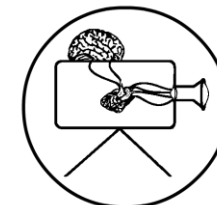


Documentary Film-making

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PROJECT DESCRIPTION

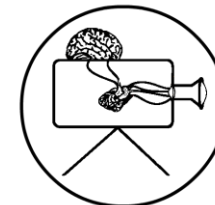
The current world is full of challenges for democracy like refugee crises, conflicts, security issues and hate speech, young people are particularly vulnerable to social exclusion, instability and aggression. Democracy is not possible without equality and having the same access to the rights, that is still the case for many young people with disability or belonging to some minority groups. In this TC studying together real-life cases and successful examples of inclusion of young people with Autism, activism, learning theoretical background of impact of video tools will become base for the knowledge vital for youth worker. On the other side participants learning in the inclusive group will develop personal competence of leaving and working in the mixed group, which will be equally beneficiary for both - people with and without special needs. From the life skills all participants and particularly participants with special needs will develop autonomy, discipline, traveling and ability to communicate as part of the learning process by using appropriate means.

Participants will learn how to develop idea (script), shoot, edit and disseminate video tools of human rights education, inclusion and tolerance.

Participant countries: Luxembourg, France, Greece, Portugal, Armenia, Georgia, Belarus, Russia

The project is financed by Erasmus+ National agency of Luxembourg: Service National de Jeunesse.

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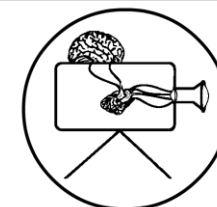
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OBJECTIVES

- To give participants opportunity to produce audio-visual materials to use in youth activities;
- To develop confidence and ability to facilitate introductory film-making workshops for peer groups;
- To develop non-formal framework for film-making as a tool for transformative learning;
- To promote the presence and the role of young people as positive actors of change in human rights, social inclusion and democracy;
- To develop the competences of youth workers and youth leaders in making films in various formats;
- To create a space for dialogue among youth and youth workers from Caucasus and Europe for fostering transnational cooperation/trans-regional cooperation in promotion of human rights through documentary film-making activities;
- To support the field presence of the European Commission in order to promote the values behind the institution.

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WORKING METHODS

All the methods will be equally accessible for everyone's participation and will be adjusted to the learning needs and styles. The education will be based on the experiential learning meaning that the participants will be learning by doing, and later will reflect the experience. Apart from the methods, we will invest into creation the safe but diverse learning environment where participants will be learning through interacting and sharing. Though most of the methods will be non-formal and non-frontal, there still will be a time for the theoretical inputs and direct guiding (especially when they will learn how to shoot and edit the videos).

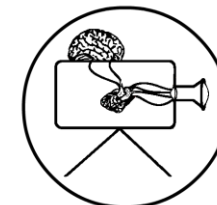
PROFILE OF PARTICIPANTS

The project is open for youth workers, youth leaders and active members of the partners organizations who is active at local level, also it is open for the participants with Asperger syndrome (at least one person per country, and if needed these participants will be accompanied by the support person).

Criteria for selection:

- Aged of 18+;
- Experience in youth work and active participation in the sending organization activities and work;
- Motivation to participate in 100% of the length of the TC;
- To take part in the preparation period online activities;

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- Commitment for follow up activities;
- Commitment to disseminate the project results.

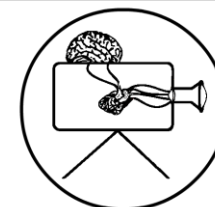
VENUE

The TC will take place in the hotel "Dghyak" in Dilijan, Armenia

ACCOMMODATION

The training course will take place in the hotel "Dghyak" which will become your home for the whole duration of the project. The rooms will be shared by 2 or 3 persons of the same sex. Each room has its toilet and shower. You will be provided with bed linens and towels (no need to bring your own ones). There will be free unlimited Wi-Fi Internet.

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FOOD AND SPECIAL NEEDS

The participants will be provided with three meals – breakfast, lunch, dinner as well as with coffee breaks. TRAVEL COSTS AND REIMBURSEMENTS

The reimbursement of the travel expenses (travel from your departure city to the venue of the project) will be made by bank transfer for all participants except those coming from Georgia, Belarus and Russian Federation.

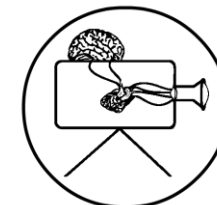

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Mandatory documents to give to get reimbursed:

1. Booking email from air company (only when booked online);

2. E-ticket or/and receipt/invoice from flights;

3. A copy of your printed electronic ticket and all other original tickets (bus/train) used during your travel to Armenia;

4. Boarding passes (of arrival and return flight). Be very careful not to lose the boarding pass. We need the boarding pass as an evidence for your flight. If you lose it, you **CANNOT be reimbursed** of your flight ticket! We will kindly ask you to send requested documents to us as soon as possible as without them we will not be able to provide you travel reimbursement, especially for what concerns flight reimbursement.

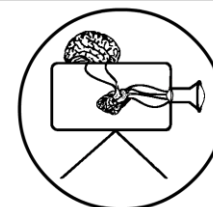
IMPORTANT: before you send the originals by post, send by email all documents scanned to foreignstudents.luxembourg@gmail.com

PARTICIPATION FEE: 30 EUR (WILL BE DEDUCTED FROM YOUR ACTUAL TRAVEL COST).

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Please note, if you bought your ticket in your local currency which might be different than EURO, we will calculate your travel costs through the official web page of Erasmus + program according to the exchange rates of the month when the tickets were bought.

NOTE: The tickets which are within the limit indicated in the budget will be reimbursed fully (reminder: participation fee will be deducted from the actual travel cost). Any amount that is more than the mentioned budget limit per country should be covered by the participants themselves.

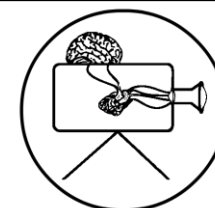
OTHER COSTS

Food, accommodation and programme costs will be provided and fully paid thanks to financial support from Erasmus + Programme granted by Luxembourgish National Agency. Insurance costs are not eligible costs, meaning that you have to support your own personal injuries insurance.

WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU

- 1. Medicines: For preventive reasons we recommend for those who have health problems to bring their own medicines;**
- 2. Any dictionaries you might need for a smoother communication in English;**

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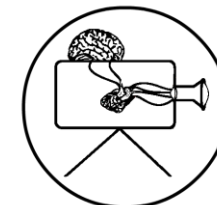
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3. An alarm clock, charger and loading cables of your e-devices;
4. If you have and consider important to carry with you - a mobile, camera, tablet, laptop ect.
5. Personal cosmetics such as shampoos, gel, toothpaste, swimming suit, etc. (but you don't need to bring towels);
6. Something warm for the evenings;
7. Walking shoes!
8. Your artistic skills! Any hidden talent that you will share with us, which you definitely will need during creativity workshops.
9. Archive footage you've made and that could be a good material for documentary films (both professional or personal).
10. Passport - Any one travelling to Armenia needs to have a valid international passport (Armenia is not a member of EU and your ID is not enough). Please, check the validity of the passports before the departure – it needs to be valid at least for three months after your visit to Armenia.

INTERCULTURAL EVENING

One of the evenings will be dedicated to the Intercultural Evening. You will present your own cultures – national, regional, personal or any kind of culture you feel you belong. This presentations/activity should not be just a “lecture” so try to find most creative way to show your culture. It means that all options are possible. A culture may be presented by a song, a story, a poem, a dance, some local special drinks or food (you will not have opportunity to cook), etc.

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You can bring pictures, music or anything which you consider to be most appropriate to present your culture. Bring CDs of traditional / typical and party music or other things typical from your country that you want to share with us during the Evening of Cultures and during other evenings.

Dear participants, we have to mention that homemade alcohol is forbidden for the evenings of cultures and generally for the project. With the homemade alcohol it is not possible to monitor the quality and we would not like to risk your health.

PARTICIPATION IN THE TRAINING COURSE

You are expected to participate fully in all activities, unless you are ill. Unauthorized absence from activities and workshops is not permitted. If less than 80% of the programme is attended, it will not be possible to be reimbursed for the international travel costs.

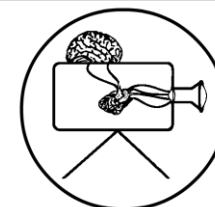
