ABOUT THE PROJECT:

The LTTC "InFormal Coaching" is a follow up of the Long-term project called "InFormal - integration of non-formal education approach to the formal education system for youth empowerment at the local level" that attempts to use coaching as a tool for youth empowerment in order to address all the mentioned issues and to build a stable and productive co-working platform for educators coming from formal education and youth field (NGOs and other youth authorities).

ACTIVITY 2 - TRAINING COURSE

24TH JULY - 1ST AUGUST 2017 | WEIMAR, GERMANY

This training course will take place in Weimar from 24 July to 1 August 2017, which is a continuation of a 1st training course that took part in Rostov, Russia from $18^{th}-26^{th}$ of March, 2017.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The second stage of the project, InFormal COACHING training course is called "Informal Coaching: evaluating and mastering" and will be hosted in EJBW, Weimar, Germany. It is the second and the last activity in the frame of the project. The main aim is to assess outcomes from the practical stage and to master coaching skills through using different coaching techniques, tools as well as discussing potential and limits of youth coaching.

Specific objectives of this training course:

- igstarrow Reflecting on the outcomes from the practical phases of LTTC
- Assessing personal and professional development
- $\boldsymbol{\diamond}$ Assessing personal coaching style and personal expression
- Discussing different approaches to coaching
- Sharing challenges and good practices, asking questions
- ✤ Assessing and evaluation of techniques of different forms of coaching
- Testing new coaching models, tools and instruments
- Planning the future cross-sectorial cooperation.

PARTICIPANTS PROFILE

The training course will offer opportunities for 27 youth leaders, youth workers and trainers to develop their personal and professional competences.

The participants are expected to have met the following criteria:

- Sincere interest and motivation to explore topic of coaching, readiness to share personal and professional experience and to learn in the international group.
- Participation in the other stage of long-term training course including the on-line phase.
- Clear ideas for follow up at local/national and international level
- Some experience in the topic of youth empowerment and high motivation to explore this topic
- Shared expectations and clearly defined learning needs

- Openness for and appreciation of non-formal learning process in high diversity context
- Commitment to go through whole long-term learning process including responsibility for self-directed learning & learning outcomes as well high level of motivation and discipline, ability to deal with procrastination that might appear during the on-line learning phase
- Commitment to reflect on personal learning process and ability to assess critically learning outcomes
- \bigstar High commitment for follow up activities and networking

PARTICIPATION FEE

The participants will be asked to pay the participation fee, which is 50.00 euros during the TC. The mode of payment can be agreed upon among the organizers and participants.

VENUE:

The training course of the project will take place at the European Youth Education and Meeting Centre (EJBW) in Weimar. EJBW has all the facilities needed for all the activities. Furthermore, the participants will be accommodated in the same venue. The accommodation of participants is in the EJBW in double and three bedrooms including full board with snacks, coffee & tea. Within EJBW several seminar rooms, workshop for creative work and free space for activities outside are at disposal. (www.ejbweimar.de)

TRANSPORTATION TRAVEL COSTS

According to the new rules within the Programme Erasmus+ / Youth in Action we will reimburse the travel costs for the TC on the basis of the cheapest possibilities, e.g. second class railway tickets, APEX-flights etc., accompanied by the receipt of complete and original tickets, invoices, bills, receipts, boarding cards etc. upon a certain "contribution to the travel costs of participants, from their place of origin to the venue of the activity and return". This contribution is "based on the travel distance per participant. Travel distances must be calculated using the distance calculator supported by the European Commission". TRAVELING TO THE EJBW

Arrival by Plane

Weimar is easily reachable from Airports Frankfurt/Main as well as Berlin. From these Airports to Weimar you can go by train. For special offers (29€ for one way by ICE) at least 4 days in advance please look at the homepage from 'Deutsche Bahn': www.bahn.de/i/view/Gbr/en/index.shtml

From the Train Station to EJBW

Arrival by Train

Take bus no. 1 (direction: Ehringsdorf) from outside the railway station to the Goetheplatz – change to bus no. 2 (direction: Bodelschwinghstraße) or bus no. 9 (direction: Süßenborn) and disembark at the bus stop "Hellerweg / EJBW". Single fare 2,00 Euro Single fare (4-ticket-set) 6,30 Euro

Arrival by Car

From the A4 motorway take the exit to "Apolda". Follow the B87 in the direction of Apolda until you reach the main traffic lights at Umpferstedt. Turn left towards Weimar on the B7 and follow the road into Weimar until you reach us on the Jenaer Straße.

CHECK LIST FOR TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT

REGULAR AIR TICKETS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE FOLLOWING:

- the original invoice (signed and stamped)/receipt/pay order/proof of payment
- the original boarding pass (the small ticket stub you receive before boarding the plane)
- the prices stated in the invoices, receipts etc. must coincide with the price on the ticket.

E-TICKETS MUST BE

- printed out and include your name, the exact fare you paid, details
 of your flight on the same page
- provided along with the credit card receipt for the payment or a copy of your bank statement (clearly showing the payment has been made)
- \$ given with the boarding pass (the small ticket stub you receive before boarding the plane)

NOTE :

- Some airlines print 'passenger receipt' at the top of the cardboard ticket. It is not accepted as a receipt of proof of payment. Therefore, if you book your tickets online, please, make sure to print out the e-mail you receive from the airline company upon the payment, stating how much and how you paid.
- Train/bus tickets must show visible arrival and departure time as well as the price (+invoices if available)

OTHER IMPORTANT DETAILS:

- Booking paper alone is not enough (we need the invoices)
- ✤ Missing or lost tickets are not reimbursed
- ✤ Any costs for taxi are not reimbursed
- Return tickets must be bought in advance before the journey
- Following the guidelines of the Erasmus+/YIA Programme and internal regulations the travel must be released by the participants on the direct way within maximum 2 days. In case of long pauses or indirect routes (holiday travel), there is no reimbursement of travel costs! Reimbursement is done in Euro.
