This international symposium is organized by the partnership of Turkish National Agency (on behalf of the Ministry of EU of Turkey), French National Agency, Italian National Agency, SALTO-YOUTH Euromed and Good Practices Resource Centre and SALTO-YOUTH Participation (on behalf of the European Commission).

The issue of youth employment has come into prominence on national and international development agendas. The youth employment is a multidimensional global challenge regardless of socio-economic development level of the population. Especially in underdeveloped economies and post-conflict countries employment opportunities are insufficient whilst large number of young people are entering labour market on yearly basis. Besides, the poor-quality education lacks building properties with the labour market. ISYEC aims to frame the extent of the issue, the motives for intervention, and the possibilities of improving youth employment through cross-sectorial cooperation.

The Symposium will address the following themes:

- Presentation of the cross-sectorial cooperation concept and sharing the existing experiences in cross-sectorial cooperation,
- Formulation of recommendations for a better cross-sectorial cooperation and its promotion within academic institutions as well as in civil society organizations.
- Sharing the existing opportunities for the empowerment of youth

Why to pay particular attention to Youth?

Regarding the youth employment challenges, the governments invest substantially on youth employment programmes, which complement policies for poverty alleviation and employment policies.

Questions arise as to the justification of the youth-specific interventions and the insufficient focus on promoting favourable investments and business climate.

Therefore, the International Symposium on Youth Employment Challenges will be a platform where the educational field (Formal and Non-Formal) and private sectors meet for the future of youth.

The official language of the symposium will be English.

The call is open for youth interested in youth employment issues, who wish to learn more about increasing their own employability, developing skills for the market and looking for great tips about entrepreneurship.

The expenses regarding logistics, such as flights (Economic Class and in accordance with EU regulations) and full board accommodation will be covered by the organisation committee.



AIMS, OBJECTIVES AND TOPICS

The aim of this symposium is to outline the dimensions of the issue, the motives for intervention, and the possibilities of improving youth employment through crosssectoral cooperation. The purpose of ISYEC is to provide inspiration, knowledge and networking in the field of youth employment and especially inspiration for crosssectoral cooperation among the private, public and educational sectors.

1. Presentation of the crosssectoral cooperation concept and sharing of existing experiences in crosssectoral cooperation.
2. The Situation of Youth Employment/Employability in the national and international level. Presentation of good practices of new tools for increasing employability such as EVS.
3. Formulation of recommendations for a better crosssectoral cooperation and its promotion within academic institutions as well as in civil society organizations (new opportunities, youth projects, women projects, inclusion projects about youth employability, etc.).
4. Policies on Youth Employability, Entrepreneurship, Intrapreneurship and Social Entrepreneurship.
