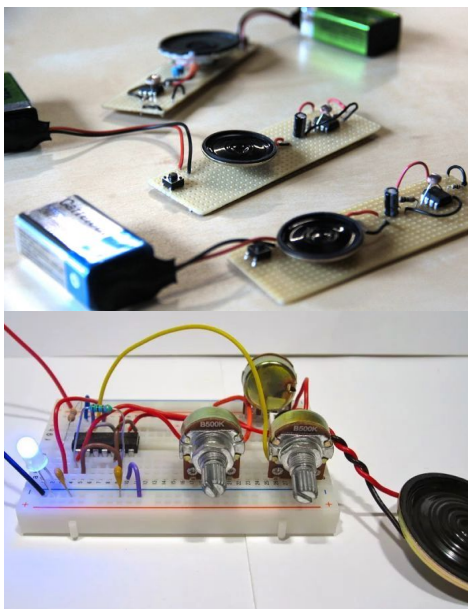
This information pack contains information about the Erasmus+ youth workers training “NOISY STUFF” which will be of interest to partner organizations and applicants of the training. Please read carefully the next chapters. Do not hesitate to contact us in case something is not clear.

WHAT IT IS

Noisy stuff is a training course for youth workers, educators, teachers, as well as anyone interested in interfacing youth work with digital DIY and music making. Participants will exchange best practices and experiment hands-on workshops on digital DIY and music making. All workshops will be held at Pralnia Makerspace, in Sokolowsko, which will enable participants to explore digital fabrication and making, and their connections with the field of education.

Examples of practical workshops which will be held on the occasion of the training course are:

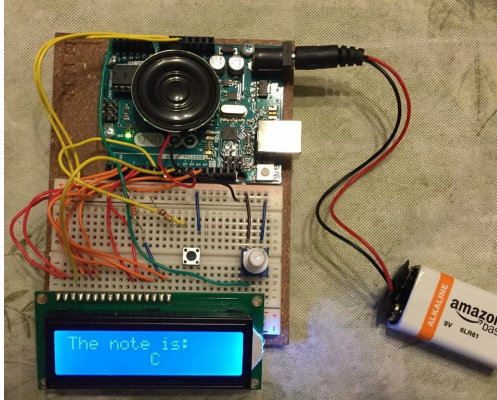
- building musical instruments from scratch, including via digital fabrication techniques (i.e. using 3D printers, CNC milling machine, laser cutter machine, etc.)



- crafting of low-cost DIY electronic sound amplifier
- introduction to computer assisted music making
- creation of low-cost DIY microphone devices
- experimentation of educational resources to teach physical computing (ex. Little bits, bare conductive, pocket operator and more...)
- introduction to electronic-based sound generation and creation of instruments
- Introduction to visual/block coding in connection with music making.



FOR WHOM



We are seeking individuals active in the domains of youth work, education (formal and non formal), digital DIY, music, social work, of any age and sex. Candidates are advised to have some background in music making, or digital DIY, or both. Participants must be able to converse in English and must be residing in one of the following countries: France, Poland, Finland, UK.

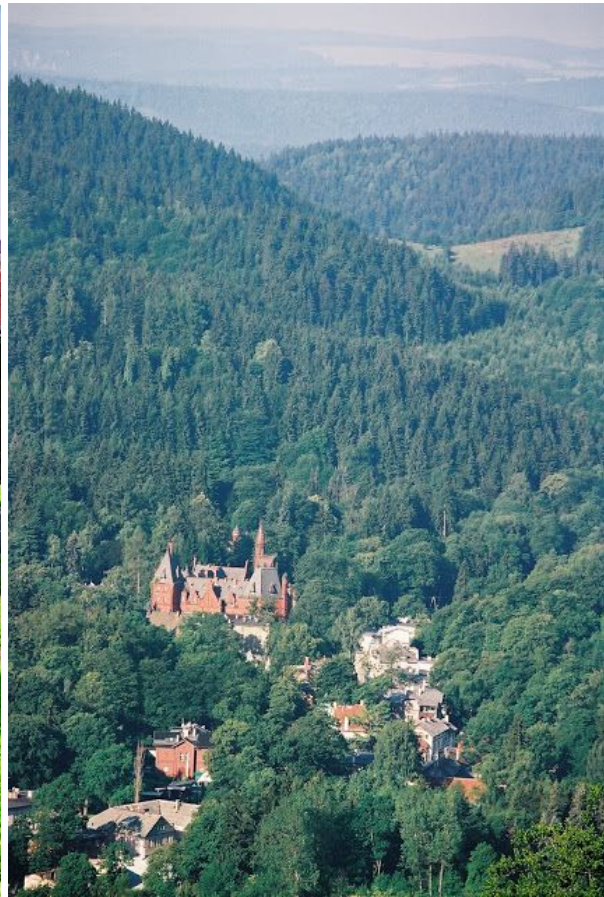

WHEN


From October **8th** to October **15th**, 2018. On Day 1 (arrival day) and DAY 8 (departure day) there will be no activities.

HOW TO APPLY

GUIDELINES ON REACHING THE TRAINING VENUE

Should you be selected for this training course, we will assist you in finding the best solution to reach the training venue from your hometown.

REFUND OF TRAVEL TICKETS

Travel tickets will be refunded after the end of the training, up to a **maximum of 275 Eur** per participating per return trip.

If you are traveling from Poland, the applicable refund threshold is **180 Eur**.

For refund purposes, you will be required to forward to the coordinating organization:

- Copies of tickets (scans of originals or electronic tickets)
- Copies of boarding passes
- Invoices relative to purchasing the travel tickets

The refund will be made by bank transfer, when all tickets and boarding passes (for the inbound as well as the outbound trip) will be handed to us.

As a general rule, we prefer to send the refund to the partner organizations' bank accounts.

However, we can make some exceptions. For example, if one person from the group buys all the tickets, we can reimburse him/her directly. It is also possible to reimburse directly each participant.

INSURANCE



Participants from EU countries should carry a European Health Insurance Card (former E111 form). Throughout the training, participants will be covered by the insurance subscribed by the hosting organization.
