Summary of Project

Thus the training course "Soft skills for youth workers" aims to develop and improve certain soft skills at youth a workers, youth trainers and youth leaders for their professional development and raising the quality of youth work.

The project will be taking place in Rucar, Romania between the 15th and 22nd of February 2019 with participants coming from 10 different program countries: Romania, Sweden, Bulgaria, Turkey, Norway, Estonia, Lithuania, France and Portugal.

The training will help acquire and improve a number of skills and abilities from five groups of soft skills:

1)Personal/intrapersonal skills. 2) Communication skills. 3) Creative thinking. 4) Presentation skills. 5)Leadership skills.

The main results of the project will be:

- 1) The development of some of the participants' soft skills;
- 2) Improvement of the participants' work quality and efficiency for their own benefit of their organizations and of the target groups.
- 3) Promotion of soft skills development among other colleagues and NGOs.

Bucuresti-Pitesti-Campulung-Rucar-Satic

Arges is one of the most industrialized counties in Romania, with: one oil refinery and two automobile plants at Mioveni- Dacia Renault car plant, and Câmpulung - ARO plant. As a tourist you can visit the city of Pitești, Curtea de Argeș, where one of the most well known monasteries in Romania is located, the Câmpulung—Rucăr area, the Făgăraș Mountains, the Transfăgărășan (which is closed during the cold season, unfortunately), the Leaota Mountains, the Poienari Castle, the Cotmeana monastery, Piatra Craiului and of course Dracula's Castle (Bran Castle)

How to get there?

If you arrive in Romania at the Otopeni Airport you can either take the bus no. 873 (from the airport's underground parking place) to Unirii Square (aprox 30 minutes) or order an Uber or Taxify (it works just fine but make sure to check the fares). Once you get to Unirii Square take the direct Metro to Pacii, from the 2nd line. Once you get to Pacii you will have to go to the minibus station (located right on the opposite side of the main boulevard) and take the one going to Pitesti. You can always ask people for information as most of romanians speak english and they can guide you. Do use Google maps or Moovit. For those of you without internet we advise that you download MapsMe.

Please keep all the receipts for travel reimbursement.

We might arrange bus for whole group from Bucharest. We will inform participants about this option once we have all flights tickets.
