ABOUT THE PROJECT

Today more than ever, the urban space is inhabited and lived by more and more people. Youth in particular live it as their third “practice ground,” aside from home and school, on their way to adulthood, thus its potential and impact is immense.

This seminar will bring youth workers, community leaders and cultural managers

together with artists who have made the urban space their own canvas for bringing social issues to the foreground. Starting from their experiences and using design thinking tools, the participants will develop new methods to connect public art, active citizenship and the revitalization of public spaces.

Over five days, 24 participants - artists, cultural managers, decision makers, educators - will have a chance to share their practices from different points of view and create new methods to connect public art, active citizenship and the urban space.

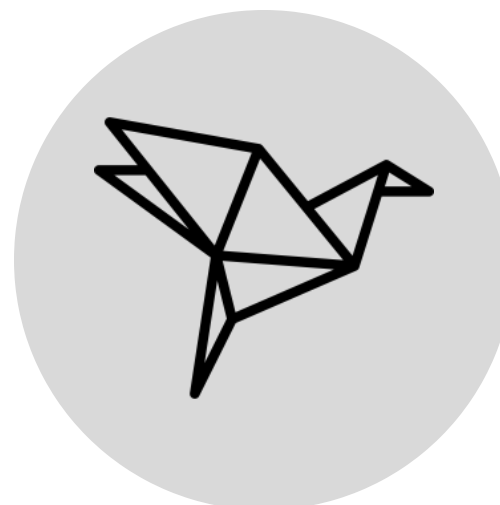

HOW TO REACH ESCH



arrival at **Luxembourg Findel**

Outside the terminal, take **bus n.16 or n.29**, stop at "**Gare Centrale**". (€2, ticket valid for 2 hrs. Can be purchased by the driver.) Journey lasts cc. 20 min.

There are at least two trains without changes to Esch every hour. Last train departs at 23:32. Journey lasts cc. 25 min. (Ticket: €10,20 Can be purchased online or directly at the station.)

HOW TO REACH ESCH



arrival at **Frankfurt Hahn (DE)**

In front of terminal 2 entrance "departures", there is a bus leaving for **Luxembourg - Gare centrale** every two hours, starting at 05:15am. (Tickets can be purchased online on flibco.com.) Journey lasts 2 hrs.

There are at least two trains without changes to Esch every hour. Last train departs at 23:32. Journey lasts cc. 25 min. (Ticket: €10,20 Can be purchased online or directly at the station.)

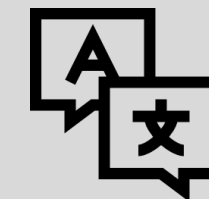
