Below you will find practical information you should know about the **House of Education**. Please read it carefully and in case of any questions do not hesitate to contact us!

1. LOCATION

The House is located in **Nasutów** - 12 kilometres from Lublin (more information about Lublin: <http://www.lublin.eu/en>).

Nasutów is a village situated at the edge of the local landscape park and has around 1100 inhabitants.

The address of the House is:

The House itself is located in a following distance from:

- grocery 1 km (12 minutes walk)
- petrol station 2 km (25 minutes walk)
- church 2 km (25 minutes walk)
- forest 1,5 km (20 minutes walk)


2. ROOMS

There is **one room for 4**, **one room for 5** and **one dormitory for 12 people** as well as coordinator's room for 2.





There are 2 separate **bathrooms** in the House – men's and women's.



At arrival each Guest is given:

- one set of bedclothes
- one mid-size towel

Cleaning in the house is provided once during the event (in the middle day). Please note that no bedclothes or towel is changed.

Please remember to take your own slippers.

3. FACILITIES

Guests are provided with following facilities within the House:


- Fully equipped kitchen

Equipped with dishes, basic pottery and cutlery - available to be used for preparing own meals.



- Workshop room

For 24 people - available to be used on coordinator's/leader's permission.



- Living Room


Room for 15 people to play games and enjoy rest.



- Fireplace outside the House

A place to organize a fire or barbecue.





Guests are also provided with following entertainment:

- board games
- soccer and volley balls
- volleyball field
- badminton sets
- croquet set

Wireless internet connection is provided inside the House although please note that the network can be lost sometimes due to the distance from transmitter.

4. RULES OF THE HOUSE

We pay much attention to philosophy of the House. We want it to be a place that is friendly and open for **everyone to feel comfortable**.

My freedom ends where the freedom of another person begins (Alexis de Tocqueville).

That's why during your stay you are obliged to obey **Rules of the House**. Here are the most important ones:

- **Cleaning after oneself**

While cleaning is provided once for the event it is important for your and others comfort to **keep your surrounding clean** inside and outside the House.

- **Cleaning shifts**

On arrival Guests will be asked to **support each other with basic cleaning duties** to keep the place comfortable during stay.

- **Night hours: 23.00-6.00**

Paying attention to comfort of those who want to rest, there are night hours provided for the comfort of Guests. Between those hours **no music or loud behaving is allowed**.

- **Energy saving and waste selection**

As we are environmental friendly you will be asked to **turn off the lights** when leaving rooms and other facilities as well as to pay attention to **waste selection** into provided bins.

Full list of the Rules of the House is displayed at the House and will be introduced on arrival.
