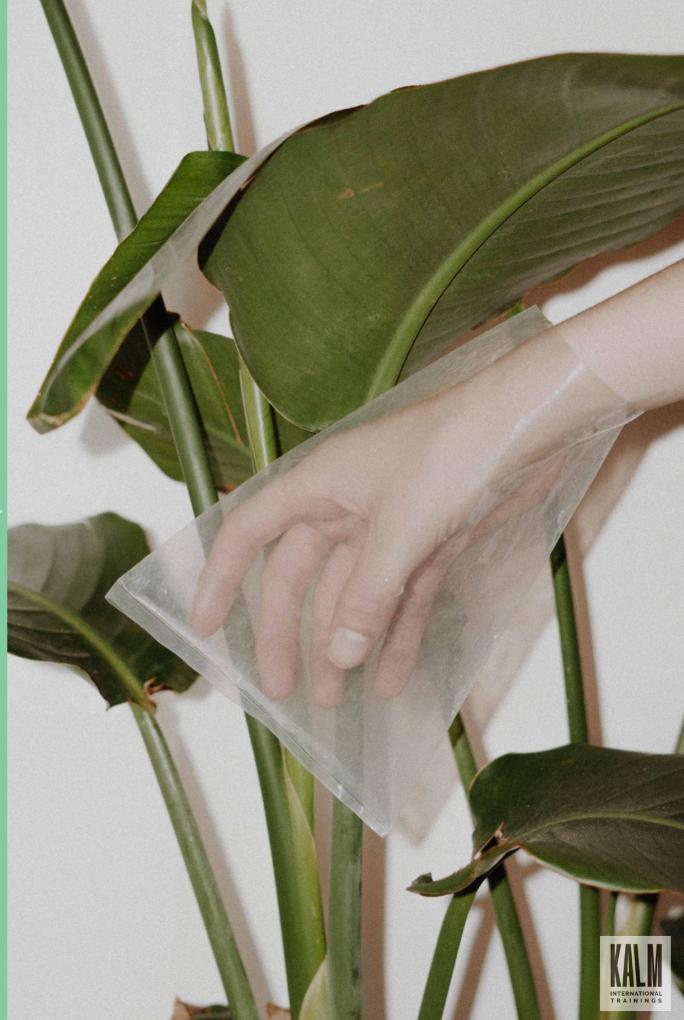

Where applicable, we strongly recommend you to also bring the European Health Insurance Card (http://ec.europa.eu/social/main.jsp?catld=559).





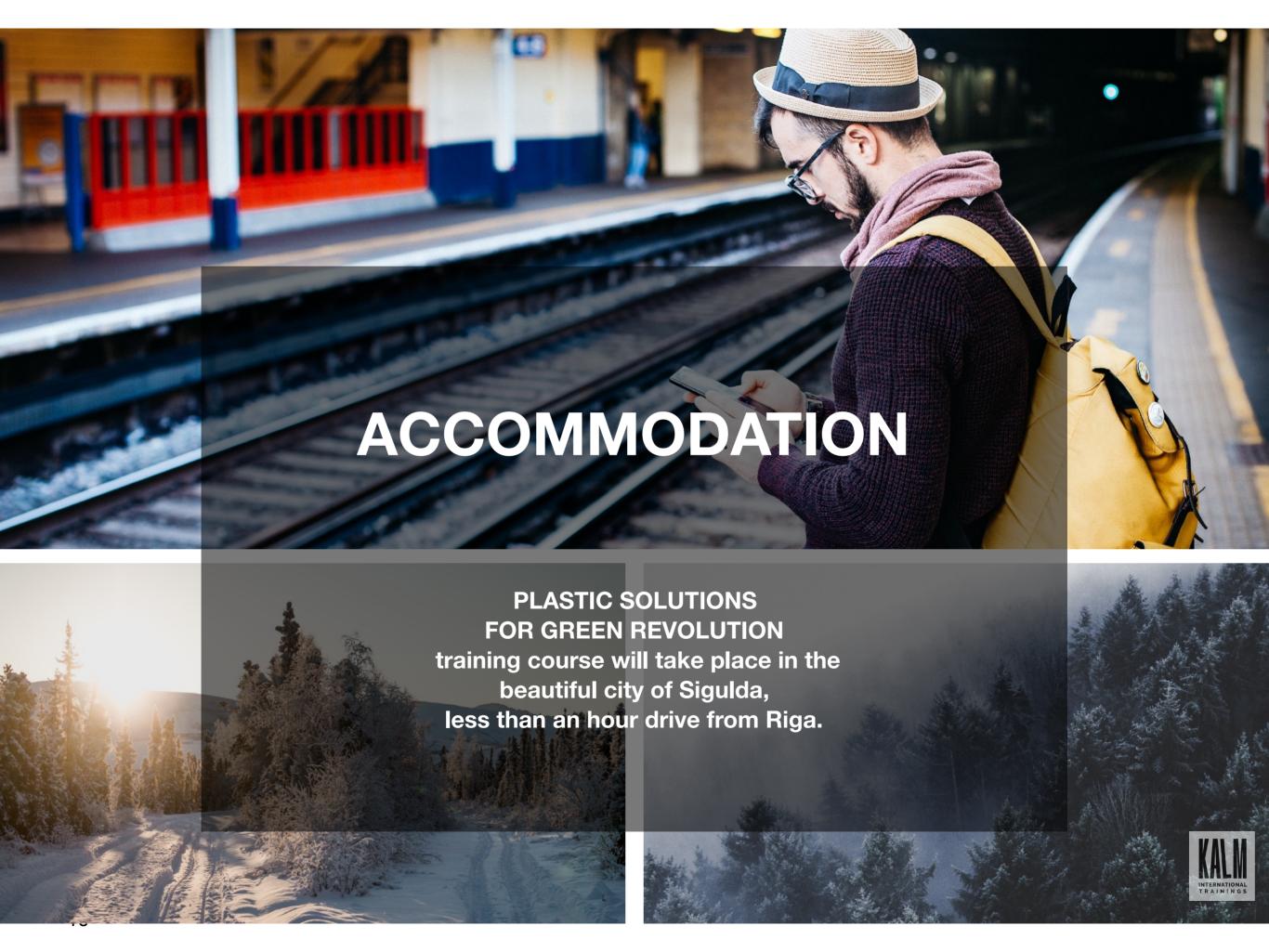

Sigulda is a must visit in Latvia because of their ancient castles and stunning scenery.

We will be staying in **Hotel Kaupo**: Jaunbeites,
Siguldas pagasts, LV-2150.

There is a shopping center 7 minute on foot from our venue.

Kaupo hotel is a **hostel type** accommodation with **bunk beds** and around **10 people per room**. The rooms are simple but new and nice.

There are **4 bathrooms** and **4 toilets** in the hallway.

There is a **lounge** for chilling and free time activities.

Wifi is also available.

We will try our best to make you feel comfortable, but please bring with you any medication, equipment or goods you will need to have with you.

HOW TO GET: TO RIGA CENTER

From the airport to Riga:

1) Buy the e-ticket: The bus ticket (e-ticket) costs 1,15 euro if bought before you travel. Please buy a ticket for 2 trips so you could use it for going to Riga center from the airport and for going back to the airport on your last day, so we can do the reimbursement. It can be purchased at the airport information office (Welcome to Riga!) or in little shops called NARVESEN at levels 1 and 2 of the terminal [See pictures on the left].

DO NOT FORGET TO TAKE ALL THE RECEIPTS BECAUSE YOUR TICKETS CAN BE REFUNDED ONLY IF YOU PROVIDE THE RECEIPT!

- 2) Find the bus 22: Walk outside of the airport and cross the parking lot P1, you will see a bus stop opposite the airport terminal. Take bus number 22 (destination Abrenes iela). Once on the bus remember to validate your e-ticket!
- 3) Get off at the stop called Autoosta (20-30 min ride).

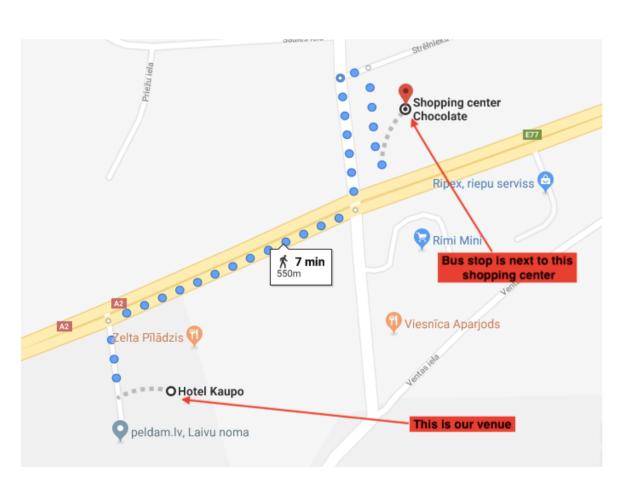


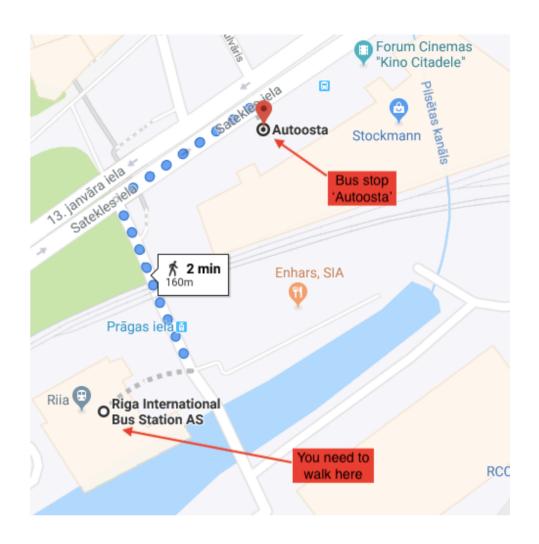
HOW TO GET: TO THE VENUE

From the city center to Sigulda:

- 1) Walk to Riga International Bus Station: From the bus stop Autoosta you have to walk to Riga International Bus Station which is around the corner [follow the directions in the picture bellow].
- 2) **Buy a ticket to Sigulda**: buy a ticket till Sigulda at the bus station. It costs **from 2,50 3,40 euros** and it's just over an hour drive.

DO NOT FORGET TO TAKE ALL THE RECEIPTS BECAUSE YOUR TICKETS CAN BE REFUNDED ONLY IF YOU PROVIDE THE RECEIPT!





At Sigulda. To the venue:

- 1) Get off at the bus stop called Allažu pagrieziens: You can show the bus driver the name of the stop (Allažu pagrieziens) to make sure you don't miss it.
- 2) Walk to the venue: the bus stop is close to the shopping center Chocolate. Follow the directions in the picture on the left to walk to the venue. It's only a few minutes:).

In Latvia you can use Google Maps for directions.

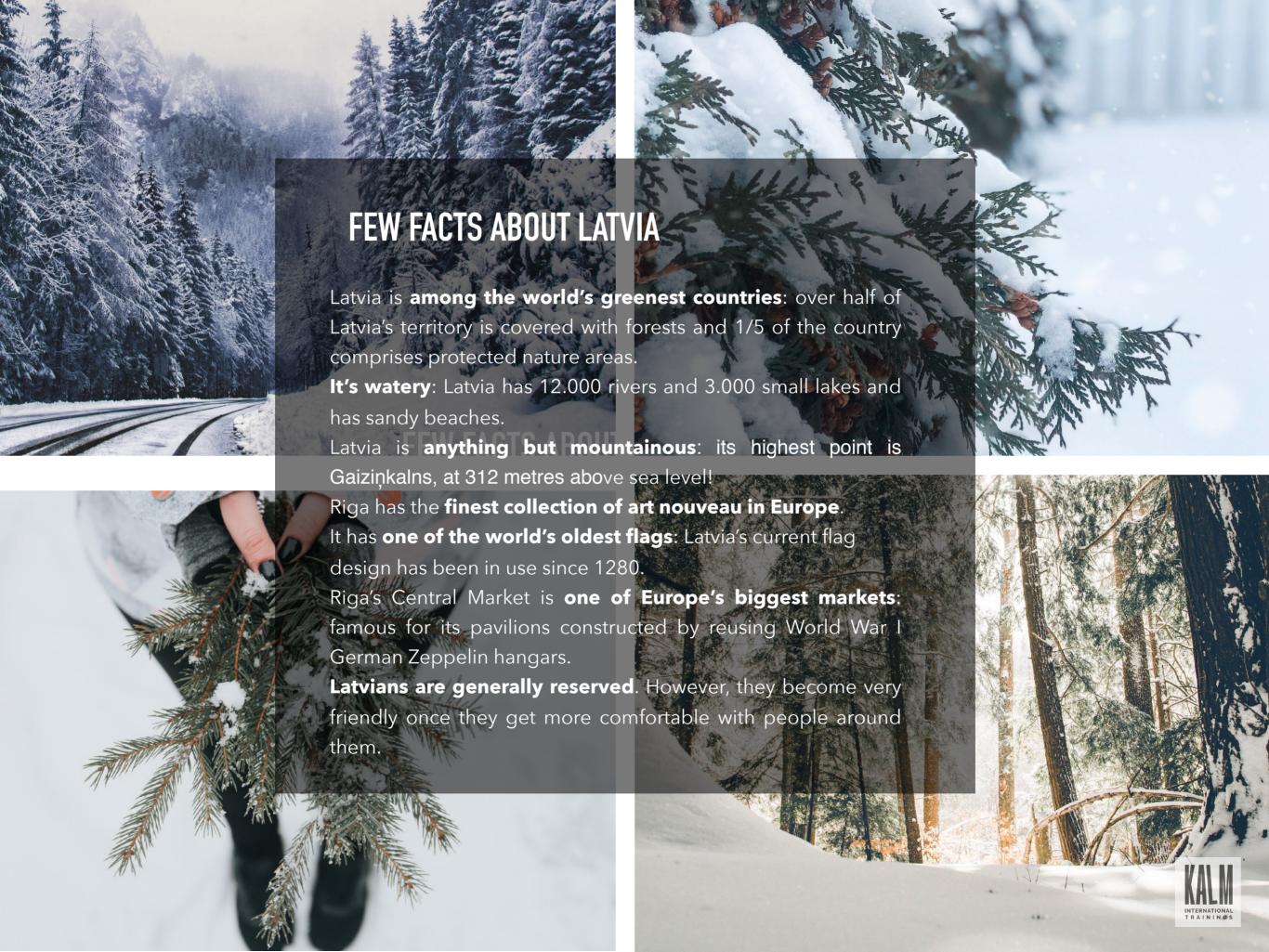

Man patīk! - I like it!



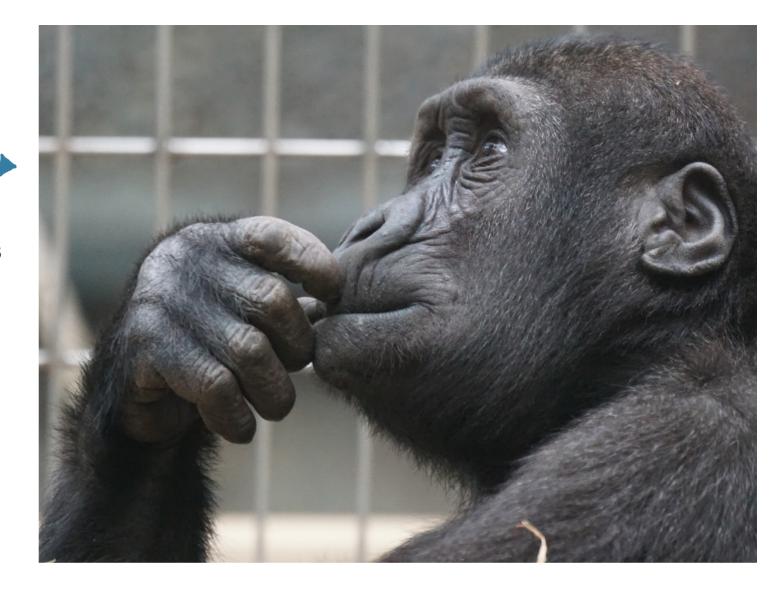
