# WHY A PARTNERSHIP BUILDING ACTIVITY ... FOCUSING ON YOUTH EXCHANGES!?

We hear it often ...youth exchanges change young people's life! And yes ... they do indeed. It is not only a great and fun project, but if done well ... especially rich in learning and empowering for all those involved!

Youth exchanges have played a very important role in the past years and remain a cornerstone in the mobility programmes of the European Commission for the coming years. The Programme Erasmus+: Youth in Action also underlines the importance of such Youth Exchanges as a powerful tool for young people to empower themselves and to grow towards active citizens of their own community up to European and global level.

The National Agency of Norway and Portugal for the Erasmus+: Youth in Action Programme launch therefore this Partnership Building Activity (=PBA), with a clear focus on increasing the cooperation between NGO's and groups from Northern and Southern Europe. "MAKING THE DIFFERENCE 6" aims therefore also to connect the young people from both corners of Europe, particularly with the age range 15-20 years old.

The 6<sup>th</sup> edition of this successful PBA will take place in a rural village in the centre of Portugal: 'Vila da Marmeleira' with about 350 habitants, combined with lodging in the nearby city Santarém. Hereby offering additionally both a rural and urban dimension. Over the past years, different international activities (including YiA) have been introduced in this community, offering a win-win situation for all involved. Local development/change through their involvement in the activities and a deep intercultural experience for the participants placed on the foreground. The community project 'Rural Centre of Non Formal Education' is in charge of practical organisation of this PBA. This village seems to us a perfect setting to organize this Partnership Building Activity "MAKING THE DIFFERENCE", where NORTH MEETS SOUTH ...and the other WAY AROUND ...

## TARGET GROUP

- → Max. 30 participants from NORWAY, PORTUGAL AND COUNTRIES FROM NORTH & SOUTH OF EUROPE
- → Being able to use English as working language
- → Having a true and real interest in establishing partnerships
- → Youth workers and youth leaders who can represent their youth group's interest
- → This Partnership Building Activity is also open for youth workers and leaders who wish to start with youth exchanges in their organization or group.









#### **OBJECTIVES**

- To create an opportunity to find good and reliable partners to make youth exchanges with
- To understand what is needed to plan a youth exchange of good quality.
- To create a solid networks of contacts and partnerships
- To equip the youth workers with insight in their role as coach and support.
- To experience the possibilities of local involvement.
- To understand the impact and social change a youth exchange can have within the local community.

Participants are expected to be part of the full duration of the Partnership Building Activity. All board and lodging is foreseen from Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> of April dinner time, till after breakfast on Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> of April 2020.
