TRAINING COURSE INFOPACK







Dear participants, welcome in the project "LARxPerience."

LarXperience is transnational strategic partnership project. Main objective of this project is to form attitudes of young people, especially in the field of tolerance to differences and in the decision making on important issues of their lives and bearing consequences for these decisions, through using larps as educational method.

Larp is a specific type of role-based game. Larp allows participants to experience deep emotions and to open up a variety of themes and to perceive them from safety of their role from which they came out at the end of the game. Due to the time limit of the game, the actions are reflected immediately and there is a clear link between them. This leads to awareness of the consequences and confrontation, how participants experience similar situations in their personal life. There is no scenario of the game, the result of the game is up to participants.

We would like to introduce this educational method to you. So we would like to offer you participation in the training course, that is going to be part of this project.

The objective of the training is to enable participants to understand what larp is, enable them to experience larp from the point of view of participants but also from the point of view of facilitators, make them understand how to use larps, how to introduce and facilitate them and how to lead reflexion at the end so the game would meet its learning objectives.

As soon as the training is over, participants:

- understand, how larp works and what are the main principles of larp game,
- know the difference between various kind of larps,
- are able to introduce larp to the group of young people,
- are able to lead reflection to reach educational objective,
- are aware of impact of larps on attitudes of participants,
- are motivated to use larps in their youth work.

At the end of the training, participants will get larps designed in the frame of this project, and they will be required to test them with their target group and send us feedback. It will help us verify the competences, they gained in this training.

The training will be held 14.08 – 19.08.2020 in Trstená, Slovakia.





PARTICIPANTS:

Participants should be youth workers or teachers who have no experience with larps or who begin to use them and need to develop their competences. We don't have any specific requirement for participants, except from the motivation to use larps in their youth work. Participants should directly work with young people, so they are able to use the method and test it with their group.

The training course can be also attended by youth workers or teachers with less opportunities, but please let us know in advance, so we can arrange sufficient support for you.

Each country should send us 5 teachers and 5 youth workers.

The minimum age of participants is 18, there is no upper age limit.

It is necessary to participate in the training course from the beginning till the very end. So please arrange your time to be there.

The working language will be English, so it is important for participants to be able to speak and understand English.

Dates agreed during our last meeting is 14.08 - 19.08. 2020 in Slovakia (Orava region, Trstená). Days of training include arrival and departure, beginning of the training is during evening time, ending during lunch time also; we will specify the time according to your ability regarding arrivals and departures. Therefor I ask you to give us details regarding your itineraries as soon as possible.
