### **About Liège**

Liege is a Belgian city on the Meuse River in the Frenchspeaking region of Wallonia, has long been a commercial and cultural centre. Its old town contains many sites of interest dating back to medieval times, such as the Romanesque collegiate church of Saint-Barthélemy. The Grand Curtius Museum houses archaeological treasures and works of art in a 17th century residence, while the Royal Opera of Wallonia has been staging operas since 1820.

The mobility was focused on youth with a disability, the social business that support and help them and ways how to foster their inclusion into society also during taking part in the European project.

- Participants must have citizenship of the partner country which they come or they must have residence permit of the country.





#### **Travel**

If you want to explore Belgium, you are allowed to arrive maximum 2 days earlier before the project or depart maximum 2 days after the project

In case you decide to use that extra time, bear in mind that during these extra days, the expenses will not be covered by us: food, accommodation, etc.

Please check all visa requirements for Belgium before you purchase your ticket. If your
passport expire date is less than 6 months, you need to renew your passport. You will

TRAVEL TIPS TO GET EASILY TO THE VENUE

1There are two main airports in Belgium: Brussels Airport and Brussels south (located in the city of Charleroi).

If you arrive at Brussels Airport: in the basement of the airport you will find a train station. There are two ways to reach Liege: 1) Take a train to Brussels midday and then a second train to Liege Guillemins. 2) Take a train to Leuven and then a second train to Liège Guillemins. WARNING from Brussels airport you have to pay an extra charge for the train called the Diabolo charge. Without this fee you can be fined when checking in the train. The Diabolo charge is  $5,50 \in A$  and the ticket from Brussels Airport To Liège is A 19,20 A 19, 20 A 19, 20 A 20 are less than 26 years then you can have a one day go pass and the price is then A 6,60 A from Brussels Airport to Liège.

If you arrive in Brussels South (Charleroi). At the airport you have to take the bus or a shared taxi to the train station of Charleroi South. The price is  $5,50 \in$  for the bus and  $5 \in$  for the shared taxi. At Charleroi train station take the train to Liège Guillemins. The price is  $14,30 \in$ . If you are under 26 years old you can take a go pass ticket for one day at the price of  $6,60 \in$ .

In Liège guillemins, you take a bus to the city centre. You can take bus 1 or 4 and get off at Place Saint-Lambert or you can take bus 25, 27 or 48 and get off at the Opera stop (terminus). The price of the bus is €2.50. When you arrive at the Opéra or Place Saint-Lambert you have to walk to Place Léopold (1 min walking from Place Saint-Lambert and 5 min walking from Opéra). From Place Léopold you take bus 69 and get off at the stop: Domaine de Wégimont. It's an hour's drive by bus. You get off the bus, cross the street and enter the domain, you will easily find the reception:)
