OBJECTIVES:

- to understand in what Europe young people want to live
- To find a space for civic engagement of young people and co-creating the future of Europe
- to discuss the role of youth work as a bridge between young people and decision makers
- to train youth workers to design and run engaging educational programs based on making movies
- creating a documentary movie on the topic of the project

Many young people say nowadays that Europe is on the crossroad. The trust in the idea of Europe is decreasing and society tend to return to national divisions. Recent events like Brexit, rising interest in right winged ideologies and Euroscepticism discourage young people to believe in the idea of united Europe. In general, young people's trust of public institutions at all levels is falling.

We observe that young people lack the sense of solidarity. They are focused on themselves and their personal well-being rather than about the society they are living in. Our society has insufficiently invested in empowering young Europeans to effectively engage in solidarity activities.

The project will provide concrete tool for educating young people how to participate in the decision-making process on different levels.

The first training will connect two main issues: low interest in social involvement among young people - we will map issues mention by young people, look at their problems and reasons for it. The 2nd issue is ability of youth workers to create educational content in the form attractive for young people - vide. Aim of the training is to equip our organizations with digital competences in recording movies. We will get professional knowledge how to create video footage for documentary movies but also how to record attractive material from our projects.

TARGET GROUP:

Training course is dedicated to experienced youth workers and trainers who have previous experience in facilitation of non-formal education activities and are working directly with young people in their countries. No technical skills in movie making are required.

NOTE: The project consists of two trainings that are complementary to one another. During the first one we will learn how to record movies, during the second - how to edit them. The final product, documentary movie will be created during both trainings. Therefore it makes sense that all participants join both trainings.

VENUE:

The Training will take place in the Educational Centre Re-Zone in Rabka-Zdrój. Rabka-Zdrój is a health resort situated in Beskid Mountains 60 km south of Krakow. The venue is located in the centre of Rabka-Zdrój, nearby the beautiful park.

The venue is adapted to run non-formal education activities and equipped with everything that is needed for the training. Participants will be accommodated in 2-3 people rooms with bathrooms.

HOW TO GET THERE:

From Kraków Airport:

Krakow Airport is the closest one to the venue and it is most recommended option. When you land at the Krakow Airport take the train to the Main bus/train Station (Krakow Główny) and follow instructions below.

From Katowice Airport:

Another airport that is relatively close is Katowice Airport. From there you can take a shuttle bus to Krakow Main Station, but you should book it online in advance. You can do it here: <https://www.matuszek.com.pl/>. Once you are in Krakow Główny follow instructions below.

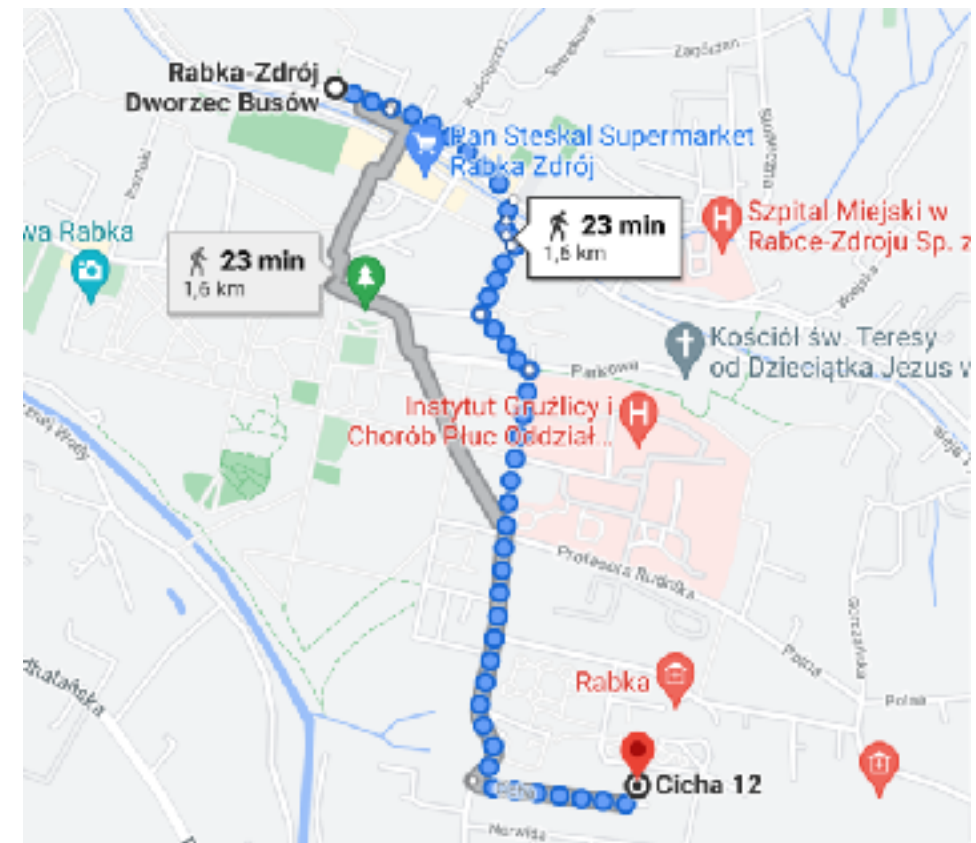
From Kraków Main Station:

Kraków Main Station connects bus and train station. Look for the signs that will lead you to main bus station (Małopolski Dworzec Autobusowy). There you can find buses that are going directly to Rabka-Zdrój. Look for a mini bus called „Rab-Bus” or „Edmar”. Trip to Rabka-Zdrój takes around 1,5h and cost 14 PLN.

!!! Keep in mind, that the last bus from Krakow to Rabka leaves at 20:00. Make sure to take a flight that arrives early enough to catch the bus. After this hour getting to Rabka gets complicated.

Once you are in Rabka-Zdrój:

From the main bus station in Rabka-Zdrój there are about 20 minutes of walking. The way is very simple and leads you through the beautiful park. Simply follow the map below to find the Cicha 12 Street.



INSURANCE:

Health insurance is not provided by the organizers, each participant is obliged to bring their European Insurance Card. We also recommend to purchase a travel insurance that covers possible cancellations or quarantine due to COVID pandemic.



FUNDING CONDITIONS:

Project is financed under the „ERAMSUS+ Programme, Key Action 1. 100% of **accommodation** and **activity costs** are covered by the programme.

The **international travel costs** are covered according to the rules of ERASMUS+ Programme. Plan your travel to Poland according to the limit in table on the right.

That means that your travel costs will be fully reimbursed up to the limit. If you spend less for your travel you will get exactly the amount you spent. If you spend more, you will get the amount from the table.

NOTE: Reimbursement of travel costs will only be done upon full attendance of the training. It will be transferred to the partner organisation bank account after receiving all the tickets. For the detailed rules of travel reimbursement please check the attached „Reimbursement Form“.

Reimbursement will be done in EURO, regardless of the currency indicated on your ticket and receipt/invoice.

COVID RULES:

All participants are obligated to respect the COVID regulations that apply in Poland and those that apply to international travels. Moreover, to assure the safety of the whole group every participant should be vaccinated, recovered from COVID (no easier than 6 months before the training) or tested (not earlier than 72h before the mobility).

To avoid additional costs or troubles during the travel we recommend to be fully vaccinated at least 14 days before the mobility starts.
