

## The 4<sup>th</sup> European event of EGL

*17-19 May 2022  
Cluj-Napoca, Romania*

The Europe Goes Local strategic cooperation will hold its 4<sup>th</sup> European event on 17-19 May 2022 in Cluj-Napoca. The upcoming European event brings together 200 stakeholders from municipal level youth work, similarly to the previous conferences of the project.

### The European context of the event

**The European Youth Work Agenda** refers to Europe Goes Local as an instrument to create bridges between the local and European level. The 4<sup>th</sup> European EGL Event is a forum where stakeholders of municipal level youth work can meet, exchange and express views, create joint activities and learn from each other.

2022 is the **European Year of Youth** with the aim of giving “young people more and better opportunities for the future”. Developing local youth work strongly contributes to addressing the needs of young people. The participants of the conference will discuss the key elements of a youth-friendly ecosystem and plan joint actions to strengthen local communities with the contribution of youth work.

### The role of the conference in the life cycle of the project

Europe Goes Local has renewed its aims and objectives for the 2021-2027 programme period.

The project is creating **a platform for stronger cooperation** in local youth work. This platform is meant to be a space for learning and cooperation for the community of youth work providers and it will be supported by activities as well as communication tools. The project is working on a new website, on the rebranding of the visual identity and an intranet application which will be offered to local stakeholders to communicate and cooperate.

### The main aims of the conference

- Launching the Europe Goes Local **platform**
- Providing space and time for the **national and regional delegations** to create activity plans to support local youth work
- Discussing the **basic youth work offer** and the role of municipalities in providing it in the context of ecosystems beneficial for youth at the local level and using the European Charter on Local Youth Work and other European instruments as tools.
- **Meeting local organisations** in Cluj-Napoca for peer-learning.

  - Partner organizations, institutions which join the Europe Goes Local platform

## Practicalities

### Registration for the event

**Participants are expected to register via the SALTO website.**

**Deadline: 28 April 2022**

Selected participants will be contacted on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of May to be able to purchase their travel ticket and to start selecting the seminar session they wish to attend.

### Arrival and departures

**Arrival day: 16 May.**

**The programme of the event will finish with a lunch at 13:00 (Eastern European Time - EET) on the 19<sup>th</sup> of May.** Participants are expected to leave the venue not earlier than this time.

Extra nights will not be arranged by the organizers.

### Travel

Travel costs are covered by the Erasmus+ National agencies from the Erasmus+ grant. Tickets are either pre-purchased or reimbursed after the event, depending on the practice of the sending National Agency.

### Board and lodging

Accommodation has been booked for all participants at in single rooms. Full board is covered for the participants from their arrival till departure. The costs of board and lodging will be covered by the hosting Romanian Erasmus+ National Agency.

### Covid safety rules

Every participant is obliged to follow the safety and entry rules of the host country, Romania.

Additional COVID-measures at the event (according to the current safety measures which might change until the event):

- Everyone will be accommodated in single rooms and we will have to respect distancing rules throughout the event.
- Every participant will be encouraged to wear face masks throughout the event.
- Participants will be asked to pay attention to hand-hygiene during the event.
- If a participant starts to feel unwell, is obligated to inform the organizers to receive the necessary help of testing or being quarantined when required.
