



Hello there!! Welcome to the project N.A.T.U.R.E.+T.C. about environmental sustainability and circular and sharing economy, where 30 youth workers from nine different countries will learn together in seven days of Training Course.

This info-pack provides all the necessary information about the project and will be a central piece of the project.

### 1. THE PROJECT

N.A.T.U.R.E.+T.C. aims to provide youth workers with competences to support youngsters to increase the respect for nature through artistic use of available technologies. The project aims to prepare youth workers to work with youngsters raising environmental awareness through creative techniques, providing and inspiring them with the framework of circular and sharing economy, collaborative consumption and the use of digital, achieving the necessary competences to combine storytelling techniques with video-making skills to engage and empower youngsters in raising also public awareness.

### The project consists of two activities:

- Preparatory visit: 30 April 1 May 2022 (excluding travel days)
- Training Course: **25 June 1 July 2022** (excluding travel days)

### Preparatory visit:

The first activity of the project will be the Preparatory Visit, 2 days at the end of April; it will be a key point for the preparation phase: defining the roles, the contributions of each partners, the final details of the methodology, visibility, dissemination and follow-up, the practical arrangements and preparation of the groups.

During the PV, 1 participant from each partner organization will take part.

### Training Course:

The TC will take place in Morfasso between - and - 2022.

During the TC, 3 participants from each partner organization will take part.

The preparatory visit must be attended by one of the three participants of the Training Course: during the selection phase, therefore, at least one participant of your group must be available for both dates of the two activities.

### 3. LANGUAGE USED

The activities of the project will have **English** as the main communication language but it is not required a fluent English level to participate.







### 4. WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Youth workers interested in learning about circular and sharing economy and the use of digital, achieving the necessary competences to combine storytelling techniques with video-making skills to engage and empower youngsters.

In order to be eligible for participation, you must:

- -Be preferably 25-35 years old (the age limit is not an exclusion criteria for mobility of youth workers).
- -Be a resident in one of the partner countries (Italy, Spain, Romania,Lithuania, Estonia, Greece, Portugal, Netherlands, Turkey).
- -Be in possession of a European Health Insurance Card or equivalent.
- -Agree to the rules & terms of the project
- -At least 1 participant with fewer opportunities per each partner (Social obstacles, Economic obstacles, Cultural differences, Geographical obstacles, Migrant background obstacle)







### 5. COSTS AND REIMBURSEMENTS

- Accommodation, food and activities' materials: 100% coveredby the EU.
- Travel costs: The travel from your home town to Morfasso and back is covered by the project budget up to a limit. This limit is set by the Erasmus+Programme rules and calculated using the Erasmus+ Distance Calculator tool. We encourage you to choose green travel if possible, avoiding airplane and using sustainable means of transport (in this case the reference budget limit is for GREEN TRAVELS). Maximum travel budgets are:

These are the maximum amounts the project budget will refund you for your displacements from your hometown to Morfasso and back. If you spend more than the maximum budget, we will not be able to refund you the difference.





### 5. COSTS AND REIMBURSEMENTS

- -Please note that there are some **important things** about the travel budget:
- -Only actual costs will be refunded. The project organizers will refund you no greateramount of money than the one you actually spent on the travels. If there is any margin between the costs of yourtickets and the maximum travel budget, it will not be refunded.
- -We can only reimburse travel costs for which original tickets/invoices/ boarding passes are provided. We stronglyrecommend you to keep all the originaltravel documents with you, since we won't be able to refund them if we don't receive them.
- -Only public transportation will be refunded. Private cars, taxis and the like will not be refunded.
- -Reimbursement will be done after the mobility and will be conditioned to the compliance with the Erasmus+ Programme rules. It means that full engagement in the activities of the training course is a requisite for the reimbursement.
- -You can stay in Italy for up to two extra days (four in case of green travels) before or after the project. In case you want to visit Italy or if the itinerary suits you better this way, you can come up to two (four for green travels) days before the beginning of the training course (25 June) or stay up to two (four for green travels) days after its end (1 July). Accommodation and food will not be provided by the project organizers on those days, but travels will still be reimbursed.

Erasmus+

To reach Morfasso, the closest airports are Milano Malpensa, Milano Linate, Orio al Serio (Bergamo), and Bologna. Here you can find instructions on how to get to Morfasso from each of these airports. But first, some important information!

-Activities will begin on 25 June at 09:00 and finish at 19:00 on 1 July. You must be in Morfasso between these two hours. Accommodation and food will be provided at Ostello di Morfasso from dinner of 24 June (arrival day) till the breakfast of 2 July (departure day).

Once you arrived to Milano Centrale station take "regionale veloce" train to Fiorenzuola d'Arda station. In Fiorenzuola d'Arda you will find Sciara Progetti's staff who will bring you to Morfasso Hostel.

Regionale veloce train from Milano Centrale to Fiorenzuola d'Arda around 9 €.


The itinerary will take approximately 2 hours and 13 minutes.







### 7.VENUE

The training course will be held in Morfasso hostel, located in Val d'Arda (PC).

Address: Località Rabbini di Morfasso 8

A structure on three floors, with a large covered porch that follows the perimeter on three sides, perfect for outdoor activities. A gently sloping lawn surrounds the Hostel on four sides.



On the ground floor, a large common room, with a reading and relax corner, perfect as a space for work and activities, is preceded by a welcoming entrance hall with reception and a small office.






### 7.VENUE

On the hall, illuminated by large windows overlooking the garden and the surrounding valley, there are two bedrooms, and a shared bathroom for people with disabilities.

The common services include another bathroom adjacent to the reception.

Adjacent to the main room there is a professional kitchen.



7.VENUE

On the first floor, we have:

- -2 quadruple rooms
- -1 six-bed room
- -1 single room for double use



On the second floor:

- -2 quadruple rooms with a balcony with a view on the valley
- -1 six-bed room
- -1 double room

All the rooms have a private bathroom.







### 8. COVID-19 MEASURES

Currently, it is possible to travel to Italy from all EU countries provided that the traveler has been fully vaccinated at least 14 days prior to the trip, has recovered from Covid-19 or has a negative PCR or Antigen test taken no more than 48/24 hours before the trip. The costs of the tests can be reimbursed up to the budget limit of 100 euros per participants.
