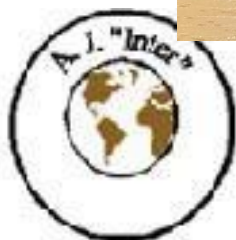


# GET INTO ESC

- Use non formal & informal education methodologies.

**ACTIVITIES:** Youth exchanges, seminars, youth initiatives, youth democracy, training courses, YiA local campaigns, KA2 (About EVS), ESC, Youth information and consulting about Erasmus+ and other European programmes as Europe for citizens. The staff has much experience working in youth information, organizing YiA/E+ projects, participating in YiA/E+ courses, with much experience working in youth information, organizing YiA/E+ projects, International volunteering (hosting & sending), trained in YiA/E+ courses, participating in EU events (i.e. EYF, Youth Week, Erasmus+ Info Days). INTER is open to any youngster, giving priority to disadvantaged (handicapped, from rural areas, unemployed). We collaborate with other NGOs & the local administration to carry out projects.

**THEME:** Training course for youth workers, youth leaders and staff members to encourage about organizing ESC projects and provide an informed introduction to Erasmus+: focusing on European Solidarity Corps and their capacity to enhance young people's active engagement.

#### **FRAME OF THE PROJECT:**

Despite growing numbers of young people and organizations that are involved in Erasmus+ projects all over the Europe, there is still a fear when it is a time to create volunteering projects. There are a lot of NGOs who don't find themselves confident enough or find difficult to understand guides written by European Commission. They don't see the advantages to join international volunteering and see themselves a bit lost to start an ESC projects. For this reason, we want to create this TC, share our information and experiences in Erasmus+ and ESC to help others develop the necessary knowledge, skills, and attitudes to organize ESC projects, based on the non-formal learning, exchange of good practices, and quality standards.

Main Goal: to show how to apply ESC and implement projects for newcomers. Specific

**Goals:**

- To provide the necessary information about quality label and ESC projects (volunteering traineeship and jobs).
- To provide practical information about essential ESC elements (OLS, ESC portal, Forms, Mobility tool...)
- To improve participant's skills in project management related to European volunteering activities.
- To create a learning experience through a simulated process on setting up an ESC project based on non-formal learning and quality standards of the European projects.
- To promote ESC to new coming NGOs.
- Provide a guide to conflict management and emergencies situations.
- To offer the opportunity to meet trustable partners to make contacts for future ESC collaborations.

**EXPECTED RESULTS:**

- Foster solidarity in the European society by engaging more young people and more organizations in accessible and high-quality solidarity activities.
- New NGOs get ready to create their first ESC project.
- Create a video guide for newcomers of the workshops of the project that collect learning conclusions to create a ESC project.
- Create a partner's network cooperation.
- Promote Erasmus+ and ESC projects with video created from our activities.
- Find out suggestions and recommendations to face conflict and emergencies.
- Create an online alternative activities proposals to face situations of confinement.
