Due to extraordinary times we live in: Host organization took extra measures in order to adapt our project to contemporary world’s realities, challenges and needs of our participants:

- All safety standards regarding COVID are observed and there is maximum mobilization from host organization;
- The hotel where actual training will take place is fully compliant with COVID-related needs
- In all respective areas of the project venue, have sprays, masks, hand sanitizers, antiseptic napkin, dezo-barriers etc.;
- All hotel staff members are vaccinated, wearing masks and special sanitary coats.
- The temperature of the staff members as well as the participants will be measured every day in the hotel.

- ▶ Trainers and organizers, managers and logistics staff are fully vaccinated and have Covid passports;
- ▶ The temperature of all participants will be measured daily before the start of the activities;
- ▶ We are in communication with local hospital in Bakuriani and if necessary we will respond quickly to any specific case may occur;
- ▶ All participants (who are not vaccinated) will be asked to have a PCR test done 48-72 hours before arrival, which excludes the presence of a COVID on the spot;
- ▶ There is no touristic season in Bakuriani in July-beginning of August and there will be not much people (not crowded streets, hotels etc) it is a small town with a total population of 1500 locals;

Project Aim and objectives.

Because of many reasons the 21st century are full of challenges and Obstacles not only in EU but around the world. The last time cases of intolerance and discrimination have increased in all of Europe: the current financial crisis, international conflicts, political confrontations, violation of human rights caused millions of people to become migrants in EU member countries. In many cases, those people had only two ways - to die or - to leave their home countries. The tolerance towards immigrants is falling and open disaster scenarios for Europe is felt in more and more tangible measure a kind of aversion to these people and to the integration of culture in general. The minorities, not only the national ones, are facing increasingly discrimination (in the real and in the Internet).

Europe needs tolerant and inclusive societies, to promote common European values, foster social integration, enhance intercultural understanding and a sense of belonging to a community and to prevent violent radicalization. Our Erasmus+ training course It`s Time to Understand is an effective instrument to promote the inclusion of people with different background

Objectives of the Project

The general objectives of the project are:

- 1) Understanding of existing problems and its causes, exploring existing lines of tensions/conflicts in Europe.
- 2) Teaching youth workers and youth activists useful tools and methodologies in order to reduce discriminatory and stereotypical thinking.
- 3) To have a space for participants to share their best practices of their local societies.
- 4) To involve young leaders from minority groups from various European and neighbor countries.
- 5) Increasing young people's (partner organizations' beneficiaries) sense of initiative and supporting them in bringing the change that suits their real needs.
- 6) developing and distributing educational materials (tool kit) that will help different stakeholders understand what youth activism is and how to support it, especially in the context of young people at risk
- 7) Strengthening partnership cooperation among European Union and Eastern Partnership countries and empowering EECA NGOs.

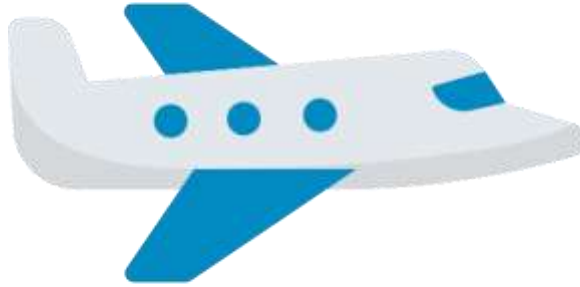
Italy - 360 Euro

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION - local transportation are VIP busses which will take all the group from Tbilisi to Bakuriani and from Bakuriani to Tbilisi, also those we use on excursion day.

COST - 30 Euro, which will be payed from your travel budget.

P.S. before buying the tickets please contact with organizers for final ACCEPTATION.

Practical information



- We highly recommend that participants have the European Health Card and travel/COVID insurance
- PSR test before to arrive on the project (48-72 Hour earlier)
- As Bakuriani is located in the mountains it can be very cold during the evenings, so please bring with you warm clothes
- Please also take: towels, personal care products, such as shower gel, shampoo, comb, etc.
- If it is possible, please bring laptops, as it can be useful during workshops, Youthpass fulfilling and evaluation of The project.
- Currency in Georgia is lari (GEL) 1 euro = 3,2 GEL
- From Airport to city centre (liberty Square) there is 1 bus N37 and it costs 0.5 Gel (0.14 Eurocent)

BEFORE BOOKING YOUR TRAVELS, PLEASE CONSULT WITH Ilona Jikia AND CHECK THE TICKETS WITH HER. WE STRONGLY SUGGEST TO TRAVEL WITHIN THE GROUPS (3 PARTC) TO ASSURE THE SAFETINESS AND MORE SUFFICIENT TIME MANAGEMENT.

Crossing Georgian boarder

1. If you have COVID passport (doesn't matter which vaccine you have) you are able to enter the Georgian boarder, just show the printed vaccination passport.
2. If you are not vaccinated than you need to have PSR test negative results, done 72 hour earlier before the entering Georgian boarder. (We are not able to reimburse your PSR test costs, because the project was approved in 2020 and there is no additional support for COVID regulations)
3. For emergency situation we are able to make PSR tests for you in the Hotel (calling company at the venue).
