C – Creativity: the ability to imagine and devise new, innovative ways of addressing problems, answering questions or expressing meaning through the application, synthesis or repurposing of knowledge.

- C Critical thinking: the ability to identify, analyze and evaluate situations, ideas and information to formulate responses and solutions.
- C Collaboration: the ability to work in a team towards a common goal, including the ability to prevent and manage conflicts.

The objectives for this training course:

to transfer to participants the idea that the world has been undergone changes, and introduce them the necessary skills and competencies of the 21st century which should be implemented in the modern educational system;

• to enrich the "toolbox" of youth workers and youth leaders with new methods and techniques that could be used in the process of non-formal education.

About the Project

Methodology

The participants will be provided with an overview of 4C main 21st century skills/competences:

Critical thinking, Creativity, Communication, Collaboration.

The participants will have the possibility to "taste" these skills/competences and get the idea of how they can be developed and improved during the youth work within various youth/social/personal and professional development initiatives and projects.

Some of the methods and tools that will be used to reach the objectives of the projects:

brainstorming, world cafe, discussions, role plays, simulations; improvisation theatre;

open space workshops;

fairs;

digitalized activities and the development of the manual; various reflection methods and many more.

In the end the participants and partner organizations will get the digital manual on the introduction to 4C skills/competences that due to its digital form may be applicable both for the off-line use in the direct work with participants and applicable specifically for the on-line

According to the current regulations, upon entering the territory of the Republic of Armenia via air and land borders travelers will be asked to:

Provide a COVID-19 PCR test certificate with negative results taken within the previous 72 hours. The certificate should be in Armenian, Russian or English, include the name, surname, date of birth and passport number of the examined person;

Provide certification of complete vaccination against COVID-19 with 2 dosages and the second dosage taken at least 14 days before entering the country;

Non-holders of the relevant certificate are subjected to PCR sampling at the airport or border checkpoint sampling points and to compulsory isolation until the negative PCR test result will be obtained.

PLEASE, KEEP IN MIND THAT:

Participants are self-responsible for making PCR tests before the project and entering Armenia. We do not cover PCR tests' costs!

Participants are self-responsible for acquiring travel/health insurance valid for the whole duration of the project, which also covers COVID-19 and flight cancellation/reschedule;

According to the rules of the French National Agency, you have 2 additional traveling days.

if you decide to use them to stay in Armenia, we would insist that you take additional days after the project (not before) to avoid the unnecessary COVID-19 risks before and within the project.

If you decide to use the traveling days after the project, remember that it's your own responsibility to organize your stay in Armenia.

Things to bring

VALID PASSPORT FOR TRAVEL;

NEGATIVE PCR TEST RESULT OR A FULL VACCINATION CERTIFICATE;

All the required travel documents (all the tickets, invoices and, preferably, online boarding passes);

LAPTOP IF POSSIBLE (WE WILL HAVE THE DIGITAL TASKS FOR 2-3 DAYS);

SOMETHING SPECIAL TO SHARE DURING THE INTERCULTURAL EVENING;

COMFORTABLE SHOES, OUTDOOR SUITS, AND BACKPACKS WHICH ARE NEEDED FOR OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES AND TRIPS;

Swimming suit;

FLIP FLOPS OR INDOOR SHOES;

PERSONAL HYGIENE ITEMS;
