CONTEXT

This training course will take place in Romania between the 9th and the 16th of August 2022. The APV will take place on day before, so on the 8th of August, in the same location.

During the APV, a group of youth workers (5) will gather to discuss the objectives of the training course, offering their inputs in making them perfectly adapted to the target group.

The training course will serve as the tool of sharing best practices among youth workers, while supporting them in improving their youth work with a focus on digital, active participation, social responsibility and professional development.

PARTICIPANT PROFILE



Youth workers

For this TC, a youth worker is someone who has worked with youth (14-35 years old) for at least 20 hours in the past 6 months leading activities linked to facilitating a learning process, guiding, mentoring, coaching, informing or supporting young people, online and/or offline, outside the formal education setting.



18+ years old gender parity good command of English language



Strong motivation towards the objectives and fields (digital, employability) of the project.

Able to carry-out preparation tasks, dissemination actions during and after the training course.



Fewer opportunities

At least 1/3 of the spots will be given to participants with fewer opportunities (economic difficulties, geographical obstacles, migrant/refugee/minority background obstacles) that have been described in detail in the registration form.



APV- ADVANCE PLANNING VISIT

The APV will be hosted in Bucharest, at Yesterday Hotel, one day before the Training Course, on the 8th of August 2022.

During the meeting, 3 participants will meet with the organizers to go over the schedule and make the last changes to make sure it successfully caters to the needs of the target group, while taking onto organizatoric roles as dissemination coordinator, logistical support or content provider.

METHODS

The Training course will be implemented with the involvement of 40 participants.

During 10 working days, the working methods will be based on non formal education, such as:

- debates,
- simulation games,
- theatre,
- team building,
- workshop,
- intercultural nights
- reflections.

Travel green



Green travel is defined as the travel that uses low-emissions means of transport for the main part of the travel, such as bus, train or car-pooling. ROMANIA


With a surface area of 238,391 square kilometres, Romania is the largest country in southeastern Europe and the 12th-largest in Europe.

Romania's terrain is distributed roughly equally between mountainous, hilly and lowland territories.


