Who?

Up to 28 activists, youth leaders, youth workers, trainers, educators, teachers and facilitators from Poland, Germany and Moldova who are interested in education for sustainable development and search for ideas how to address topics of sustainability and climate justice in their everyday work with young people. We invite also people from Ukraine and other countries who are currently staying in Moldova, Poland and Germany. Working language is English (medium language skills are enough to participate).

What? Content and topics:

- theories of sustainability and sustainable economy
- · education for sustainable development methods and insights
- steps towards everyday sustainability on personal and community level
- community projects on sustainability
- resilience in times of crisis
- dialogue and nonviolent activism

How? About the training and methods:

Training is designed and facilitated by practitioners and trainers from three countries. We create a space for learning and reflection where you can learn from each other through participatory methods. The basis of our approach is non formal education and learning by doing. During the training you will experience diverse methods and activities and have the space to share your thoughts, experiences and expertise.

When and where? About the venue:

Our training lasts from 29th of August till 4th of September 2022 (28th is a travelling day). It will take place in the village Daliowa in Beskid Niski - the wildest mountain range in Poland on the borders with Slovakia.

We will be hosted at "Dzikie Wino" - a guest house and training place which is run by local social entrepreneurship. Participants will be accommodated in rooms shared with other persons. We will provide local vegetarian/vegan food during the training.













Costs and other important information:

We have fair and flexible fee policy - we want to make our training accessible for everyone and we don't want financial reasons to be a barrier for you to take part in it. If you have any questions - contact us, we will find the good solution!

- Participants from Germany: participant's fee 140 EUR, there is the possibility to reduce the fee if needed
- Participants from Poland: participant's fee 0-80 EUR (you can choose the amount considering your possibilities)
- Participants from Moldova: participant's fee 0-50 EUR (you can choose the amount considering your possibilities)
- We cover the costs of the training, sustainable travel (up to 320€ for 500 and more kilometres, up to 210€ for 100-499 kilometres), board and lodging.
