# PARTNERSHIP BUILDING ACTIVITY

Pinos Genil (Granada) – 17<sup>th</sup>-22<sup>nd</sup> October 2022









# **CONTEXT**

Volunteer projects are a great opportunity for personal development for volunteers, as well as actions for change and improvement in the communities that host them. But there are many young people, especially those with fewer opportunities, who do not feel ready to face a long-term project on their own.

To help them embark on long-term projects we have a tool that unfortunately is used less than we need: volunteering team projects.

These projects require specific capacities in the entities that manage them and good partners that help their proper development. And for this we propose this activity.

"V Team" is a Partnership Building Activity (PBA) that aims to increase knowledge about volunteering team projects and to create a solid and trustable network of partners interesting in organizing them, both, from program countries and partner countries.

Through the principles and practices of non-formal education and in an atmosphere where participants can learn from each other, "V Team" will include teamwork and network activities, capacitation activities and exchange of ideas and practices to inspiring projects.

Also, this PBA is to support organizations in their work with young people with fewer opportunities and help them understand how volunteering team opportunities can be used to challenge perspectives on inclusion, personal development, resilience and confidence building.

### Objectives:

- To foster partnership building of potential hosting/supporting organizations equipped to support volunteering team projects.

- To support the development of partnership and sustainable networking between program countries and partner countries in European Solidarity Corps.
- To help participants gain knowledge on the key activities involved in ESC and provide a space to nurture the development of volunteering team project ideas.
- To provide a space and the opportunity for ESC coordinators to exchange their experiences, share good practices and support each other in the management of ESC volunteering team projects.
- To motivate organizations to host and send volunteers with fewer opportunities.

# **PARTICIPANTS**

People working in the organization with quality label to host volunteers. They must be people who work with volunteering projects, who know how they work and who can make decisions to create partnerships and projects.

Participants should be at least 18 years old (not age limit) and able to communicate in English.

Participants are expected to be part of the full duration of the activity.

# **TRAVEL**

On Monday 17<sup>th</sup> of October you should arrive to the accommodation before dinner (around 20.00h). We recommend taking the bus 390 (https://siu.ctagr.es/es/horarios\_lineas\_tabla.php?from=1&linea=1056 - 1.55€, you pay directly to the driver, they don't accept notes of more than 10€, only cash) at 18:20h, so you arrive on time to do the check-in, take a shower and relax a bit in your room before having dinner in Hotel La Duquesa (http://hotelladuquesa.es/). The best stop to arrive at the hotel is La Duquesa.

The next bus is at 19.40h (just on time to have dinner). Please, let us know in advance which bus you will take.

Bear in mind that after dinner we will have the first session to know each other.

If you land at Málaga airport, please, book asap your ticket to go to Granada (bus is the best option: www.alsa.es — train is also possible: https://www.renfe.com/es/en) because many buses/trains run out of seats several days before. Same if you land in Seville or Madrid.

When you arrive in Granada, to go to the bus stop to Pinos Genil (Paseo de Los Basilios).

From the Bus Station take bus 33. You will find the bus stop just going outside of the bus station, in front of the main entrance.

From Train Station, take bus 33 or bus 4. Both buses are taken in Av. de la Constitución but in different bus stops (couple of minutes from the Train Station):

If you take the bus 33, you should buy the ticket from the bus driver (1.40€, they don't accept notes of more than 10€, only cash) and stop in Paseo de Los Basilios 1 (around 20-25min trip from Bus Station and 10min trip from Train Station).

If you take the bus 4, you should buy the ticket in the machines that are at the stop (1.40€) and validate the ticket before boarding the bus and stop in Paseo de Los Basilios 1 (around 10min trip from Train Station).

On Saturday 22nd is the departure day. The first bus to go to Granada is at 8.00h (arriving in Granada at 8.40h), so bear in mind this to plan your trip back.

Please have a look on our Maximum Travel Budget chart. The amount in brackets corresponds to exceptional costs for visa. Remember, to your total budget you need to add your local transportation (getting to an airport and so on). Keep in mind, if your total budget ends over of this budget below, we are not able to reimburse you the extra cost.

Participants or organizations should arrange their trip (but please, don't buy tickets before our approval). We will reimburse that cost when we receive all the documents we need (invoice, tickets, boarding passes, etc.). Note that it is not possible to reimburse without the original tickets and/or boarding passes. In addition one invoice that shows the name of the participants, date, route and price. Original invoices and tickets must be delivered during the activity, except for those needed for the return trip, which should be sent after the end of the activity.

We will make one bank transfer per country, so until we have all the documents from the whole group we will not be able to reimburse.

Please, bear in mind that some companies (Ryanair, etc.) delete the boarding passes from their Apps after the flight. So download your boarding passes in PDF as soon as you have them and send us by email (tul@lasdeltul.net).

Useful tips and information about your stay:

- ✓ Don't forget to check the requirement to come to Spain: https://spth.gob.es/
- ✓ The meals will be fully covered for the full duration of the activity from the dinner on the 17<sup>th</sup> to the breakfast on the 22<sup>nd</sup>;
- ✓ Keep all the originals of boarding passes and tickets with you. With no original docs we can't reimburse it;
- ✓ Bring some traditional food/snacks/drinks from your country/region for the Intercultural activity (we don't have the chance to cook). We invite you to prepare some games, dances, songs... but better if it is something interactive and funny. PowerPoints or videos are really not recommended. Around 5 minutes per country;
- ✓ Make sure you have health insurance (European health card or other) and travel insurance (this could be part of the travel reimbursement);
- ✓ If you have the option, bring a laptop or tablet to work during the activity, it will be useful;
