PROJECT DESCRIPTION

In 2018 the project <u>"Venues of Victims // Venues of Perpetrators. Mapping, Decoding & Processing the Role of Historical - civic education in (European) Youth Work</u> was successfully implemented by EJBW and its international partners from 12 European countries. After the evaluation, EJBW and its partners decided to develop a follow-up project based on the positive experiences made, while actively addressing the challenges identified by the completed project.

The project edition 2021/2022 started with a Kick-off Meeting, in which the content and strategicorganizational aspects were worked out with the project partners; followed by a Training Course and an International Summer Camp, which was prepared and mainly carried out by the participants & youth leaders. The project is focusing on various aspects of dictatorial orders and authoritarian forms of rule in post-war Europe. In addition to dealing with political violence, arbitrariness and propaganda, the project is tackling the topic of everyday life under dictatorial rule. Further, topics such as resistance and fighting for democracy, peace, human rights were considered.

AIMS & OBJECTIVES OF THE YOUTH CONFERENCE (CLOSING EVENT)

The planned event is aimed at closing this year's project circle within the overall project "Venues of victims // Venues of perpetrators". Therefore four main program elements ("pillars") are foreseen:

- Focusing on **remembrance culture in Portugal** (history, legacy, remembrance, implications of Salazar dictatorship)
- Abstracting results and challenges of this year's project edition and transforming them into prolific discourses (risks, limits, potentials)
- Giving space to participants and project partners in promoting relevant themes/ topics/discourses
- Creating a framework for **networking and development of follow-up proposals** & further project ideas

The planned event in Lisbon is open for representatives of the project partners, former participants of the project edition, future networking partners and an interested audience from the field of youth work, civic-education and science from Portugal as well as the countries of the partner consortium.
