THEME OF THE PROJECT

WHAT IS THE PROJECT ABOUT?

Despite growing numbers of young people and organizations that are involved in Erasmus+ projects all over the Europe, there is still a fear when it is a time to create volunteering projects. There are a lot of NGOs who don't find themselves confident enough or find difficult to understand guides written by European Commission. They don't see the advantages to join international volunteering and see themselves a bit lost to start an ESC projects. For this reason, we want to create this TC, share our information and experiences in ESC to help others develop the necessary knowledge, skills, and attitudes to organize ESC projects, based on the non-formal learning, exchange of good practices, and quality standards.

Age: Over +18

Who: Youth workers (grassroots, involved in youth work and directly working with young people), staff members of NGOs, youth leaders, educators, young people of non-formal groups who are interested with ESC.

Time of the project: 14-20 December 2022

Countries and group size: Hungary, Italy, Estonia, North Macedonia, France, Romania, Spain, Greece, Türkiye, 23 participants in total. Except Spain and Turkey, each country will join the project with 2 participants.





MAIN GOAL

To show how to implement and apply ESC projects for newcomers.

GOALS

- To provide the necessary information about quality label and ESC projects.
- To provide practical information about essential ESC elements (OLS,Cigna,ESC portal, Mobility tool...)
- To improve participant's skills in project management related to European volunteering activities.
- To create a learning experience through a simulated process on setting up an ESC project based on non- formal learning and quality standards of the European projects.
- Provide a guide to conflict management and emergencies situations.
- To offer the opportunity to meet trustable partners to make contacts for future ESC collaborations.

EXPECTED RESULTS:

- Foster solidarity in the European society by engaging more young people and more organizations in accessible and high-quality solidarity activities.
- New NGOs get ready to create their first ESC project.
- Create a video guide for newcomers of the workshops of the project that collect learning conclusions to create a ESC project.
- Create a partner's network cooperation.
- Find out suggestions and recommendations to face conflict and emergencies.

- Please bring from your country **2 Antigen Self Covid tests** for yourself. In case of emergency or doubt, you might be using it.
- In your national team you will be responsible to implement **4 energizers** during the project. You will also promote your organization to other participants. If you have, please bring promotional materials, flyers or information about the organization you are representing.
- Please bring some typical local products from your country for the cultural evenings that will take place. Moreover, you will have 20 minutes to present your country.
- Do not forget your ID & passport, your smile and positive energy:)







Please search your flight tickets until Ankara (Esenboga airport). Airport has good public transportation; pick a public transportation bus. There are 2 companies. One is called **Havaş** and the other company called **Belko air**.

You should take Belko air company and stop in Kızılay (do not take Havaş bus). They are just in front of the airport. If you do not see the buses, you can ask anybody they will show you. Trip takes 45 minutes. The ticket will cost 27 liras. You will pay the cost inside. We will be waiting you in bus stop in Kızılay and take you to the hotel.

Ankara

Ankara is Turkey's capital and the second largest city of the country. It is a old city with various Hittite, Phrygian, Hellenistic, Roman, Byzantine and Ottoman archaeological sites. The city's name goes back to the Angora cat (a particular race with two different eye colours). Nowadays, the population of Ankara is 5,445 million people.

We will stay in **Elit Palas Hotel** with 2-3 people rooms, mixed nationalities.

COVID-19 REMINDERS

In case of Covid-19

- In case we have a Covid-19 situation, the Turkish coordinators will be in charge of helping the participants.
 We will follow the current regulations of Turkey and the EU.
 That will include hidroalcoolic disposal, masks and self covid test in case of any symptoms.
- Measures like quarantine will be applied in case of Covid symptoms. There is no quarantine anymore for asymptomatic or low incidence.
- In case of any positive cases, we will assemble those and also separate possibly infected (contact) persons.
- As this project was written and accepted before the pandemic situation of Covid-19, this project does not have a budget to pay the accommodation in case of extra stay.



Currency

The currency of the Turkish Republic is the Turkish Lira.

1 Euro is 18.15TL (03 November 2022)



At the airport, the exchange money rates are not very good. Therefore, we recommend to not change large amounts of money at the airport (at the most 5-10 euros). We can help you during the project to change money with a better rate.

Time

The time in Turkey is given by UTC+03:00 year-round. This time is called Turkey Time (TRT). Turkey is 2 hours ahead of Central European Time.
