






PARTICIPATION - UP! 2.0

About the project

The project idea is to bring together 30 young leaders/workers from Germany, Ukraine and Georgia and empower them by exchanging the best practices on the topic of youth participation.

The aim is to promote alternative forms of participation via creative performances, online activities, and other means of involvement and carry out video instructions, the publication (toolbox) and via local actions test them and create a new mindset within organizations and young people for further exploitation of the innovative methods of participation in participating countries and beyond.

Project is organized by youth organization **Umbrella** (Georgia), in cooperation with youth organizations **Development and initiative** (Ukraine) and **New Horizon** (Germany).

The project is financed by **EVZ foundation and the Federal Foreign Office** in scope of MEET UP! Youth for Partnership funding program.



About the project

The objectives of the project:

- 1. Exchange the best practices of the participation via alternative means among participations and thus promote/equip participants with alternative participation-related competencies.
- 2. Promote alternative ways of participation within the participating youth organizations and beneficiary young people at organizational, local, national and international levels via concrete action plans.
- 3. Explore digital tools (webs and mob apps) in promoting youth participation including alternative ways.
- 4. create intellectual visual outcome(s) (booklet and e-visual resources posters, videos, pics) for the further dissemination.

5. promote intercultural dialogue and exchange among participants.

Participants' profile

There will be 10 participants + 1 project head + 1 facilitator per country.

The participants will be selected based on the main criteria:

- Being aged 14-35.
- Knowledge of English.
- Representing the country of partner organization Ukraine, Germany or Georgia (citizen or residency).
- Motivation to take part fully in the project including local actions and planning.
- Being involved in the partner organisations' work as volunteer or member is an asset.
- Having experience in public/civic activisms or working on the topic of participation is an asset.



Gender balanced group - it is strongly recommended the composition of the national groups to be gender balanced.

In case of selecting participants aged less the 18 years old a parental consent will be signed.



Participants' Tasks

Before coming to Georgia, participants in national groups have to do some tasks:

Discover and prepare a short presentation about the practices of alternative participation in your countries.

Think about the ways to present your country and sending organization in 10 minutes



The training course will take place in Bakuriani, Georgia, one of the most popular ski resorts. With its breathtaking mountains and nature, it is popular all year.

During the training course, the participants will stay in Hotel Grand Noel and will be in shared rooms (3 people in one room).

Accommodation and meals (3 courses + 2 coffee breaks a day)



Travel costs

All travel costs will be reimbursed upon the sufficient receipts, tickets, boarding passes and invoices. The reimbursement will be done after the training course, after being involved in follow-up activities.

In case participant will not be involved in organizing follow-up activities, the organizer has right not to reimburse the travel costs.

The reimbursement limit depends on your country:



Germany - up to 500 Euros per participant



Ukraine - up to 300 Euros per participant

Tips before you purchase the tickets:



It is recommended to buy the tickets in Euros.



Save the tickets, boarding passes, invoices. In case you will not have them, we will not be able to reimburse.



Don't buy the tickets until you receive the confirmation from us.



You can arrive in Tbilisi or Kutaisi international airports.



Only the most economical ways of travel will be reimbursed



How to apply?

There will be separate application forms shared by the partner organizations, where you can apply, depend on your country.



You can send your application form before 1st of March!
