

YOUTH WORKER EXCHANGE CANDRIA - ITALY 16-22/06/2023




Youth worker exchanges are part of the European Erasmus+ programme which offers opportunities to organise projects for the mobility of young people and youth workers. For youth workers, organisations can take part in opportunities to support the professional development, capacity building, network of youth workers and thereby the development of quality youth work at local, regional, national, European and international level, through non-formal and informal learning experiences in mobility. More specifically, mobility projects for youth workers aim to:



• Build a community of youth workers that can support the quality of projects and activities for young people in EU programmes and beyond;

Develop local youth work practices and contribute to capacity building for quality youth work of the participant's and their organisation, having a clear impact on the participating youth workers' regular work with young people.



What are we are going to do?

The exchange will take place from the 16th till the 22nd of June 2023 (16 and 22 being travel days)




Board and lodging

INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL

Actual travel expenses from the country of residence to the place of exchange will be **reimbursed** up to the amount indicated below. The refund will be made *after receiving the complete travel documents*. The maximum amount of travel costs will be calculated according to your residence in your country to the place where the exchange takes place (Trento) according to the distance band provided by Erasmus+ programme

eligible transportation

Participants must travel by public trasportation (plane, train, buses) in the dates specified (16 and 21) in order to get the reimbursement.

| Travel distance | Standar travel |
|-----------------|----------------|
| 10 - 99 km | 23€ |
| 100 - 499 km | 180€ |
| 500 - 1999 km | 275€ |
| 2000 - 2999 km | 360€ |

How to get to Trento?



By Airplane

Trento doesn't have an airport. Therefore we have to choose the closest airport to Trento that has a good bus or train connection.

We recommend **Bergamo (BGY)** as it has a good Flixbus connection to Trento. Depending on your finances and ease you can choose either one of the listed options.

NOTE: before choosing the flight, make sure that here is a FlixBus or a train connection that matches your flight.

For some, the train might make more sense. Trento's station is located in Piazza **Dante.** You can buy the train tickets online.

We recommend not to book return tickets for early morning in order to have time to reach the airport (see first bus/train connections): it will be difficult to find transport to your chosen airport early in the morning.





InCo - Interculturality & Communication is a non-profit association in Trento who's aim is to create opportunities for people of different cultures to meet in order to increase intercultural sensitivity and international solidarity among young people, to encourage their active participation in society, but also to offer concrete opportunities for non-formal learning, personal and professional development. InCo organizes and manages international mobility projects for young people and youth workers since 20 years, hosting 30 ESC volunteers (10-12 months) each year, organising youth exchanges and youth workers exchanges every year.
