The program will comprise of approximately 8 working hours per day and include several breaks and free time to explore Maribor and socialize in a more non-formal setting to encourage networking and experience sharing between participants.

The order of the sessions might be different (depending on the availability of the trainers for specific topics).

LOGISTICS

Accommodation and food costs will be fully covered by the organizers (4 nights, 4x breakfast, 3x lunch, 4x dinner).

Travel costs will be covered by the organizers:

- up to 275€/person for participants from Romania,
- up to 180€/person for participants from Croatia and
- up to 20€/person for participants from Slovenia (carsharing and other green travel options are highly encouraged).

All travel arrangements will be made in collaboration with Zavod Nefiks, Asociatia ProDemocratia (Romania), Inkubator sreče (Croatia) and Moral diplomat (Croatia).

ABOUT THE PROJECT YOU(TH)APP

Based on the needs of youth workers in the 3 participating countries, the objectives of the You(th)APP project are to:

- raise the quality of youth work by using alternative methods;
- strengthen the capacity of youth workers in their work without an online connection and, as a result, the competence of young people for participation and implementation of youth work;
- strengthen the knowledge and competences of 30 youth workers;
- promote the recognition of the profession of youth worker and youth work among target groups.

As part of the project we did a research about the needs of youth workers in Slovenia, Croatia and Romania. The results of this research serve as a base to create the mobile app and this training course.

ABOUT MARIBOR



Maribor (the second biggest city in Slovenia) is surrounded by the green forests of Pohorje, a sunny wine-growing region and the Drava River that runs through the city. Maribor is a charming city with rich historic and cultural roots, reaching back to the Middle Ages. The Guinness world records tell the tale of rich wine tradition, the oldest vine in the world, which is found in the city centre, as well as the wine roads in the vicinity.

The city of Maribor has a pleasant location at the crossroads of an important European path leading from the west to both the east and south Europe; and it is located only 11 km from the Austrian border. It is only 45 minutes from the Austrian city of Graz and 1.5 hours from the Croatian capital, Zagreb. The city is easily accessible from all the neighbouring countries, as it has good road and railway connections.

Participants will share rooms with 4 separate beds and private bathroom, wifi is available throughout the hostel.














ABOUT SLOVENIA
