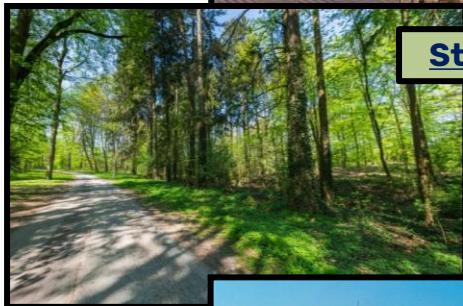

- Take the Railjet (Rj) direction Salzburg to get to St. Pölten Hbf (29 min)

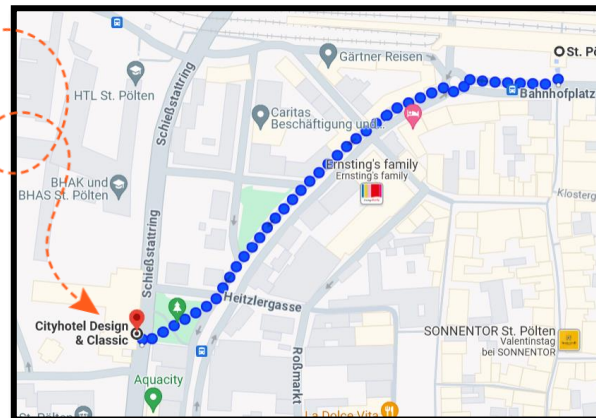
From St. Pölten Hbf

## Objectives



- To learn about current digital tools and technology trends relevant to youth work.
- To gain practical skills in incorporating Digital tools and AI into daily youth work.
- To encourage critical thinking on the ethical considerations of AI and digital tool usage in youth work.

## Methodology



This is a four full-day Training (+ arrival and departure days). It is a learning-by-doing experience built on a simulation exercise combined with workshops, info sessions, and other engaging activities. Participants will actively engage in hands-on sessions while reflecting on the experience and taking valuable insights and ideas applicable to their daily work with young people.

## Target Group

Participants should be fluent in English and have some basic knowledge about technical tools.
