ABOUT THE ACTIVITY

With this activity we pretend to have a common understanding of the whole process of a Youth Exchange project within Erasmus+ focused on the participation of young people with fewer opportunities.

It is not always easy to find partners for these projects who want to work with inclusion profiles, who share the values necessary for this and who apply quality criteria that allow the development of successful projects.

Objectives:

- To explore essential aspects of Youth Exchange projects, understanding the main principles of project cycle.
- To stablish quality requirements for inclusive Youth Exchanges.
- To create opportunities for participants for sharing good practices and networking.

We will base our work on the quality standards focus on inclusion of highly vulnerable young people and young people under 18 years old developed by the informal network led by Associazione JOINT.

PARTICIPANT PROFILE

25 Participants +18 y.o. will attend the project We are looking for people who...

- Are professional or volunteer youth workers already working or willing to work with young people with fewer opportunities using youth exchanges.
- Are able to communicate in English (it will be the main working language).
- Are directly working (as a professional or as a volunteer) in an organization or institution based in one of the Erasmus+ Youth programme countries.
- Are able to take part in the entire duration of the training course.



ACCOMMODATION

We will stay in the hotel "La duquesa", located in Pinos Genil. It's a big hotel with double and triple rooms that you'll share with people from other countries but same gender.

Rooms are equiped with everything you could need, including towels. Working and dining rooms are in the same venue.

TRANSPORT

Once you are in Granada, you have to take the bus to Pinos Genil

*You can take up to 3 extra days before/after, but you need to pay for the expenses.

*We need participants to be in Granada by the 13th at 7 pm at the latest (if you want to have dinner) and depart on the 19th after breakfast.

Arriving from Malaga airport:

Malaga has an international airport, which is very well connected with Granada. There are many buses and from there you can get to Granada in 2 hours (some of them are departing from the airport). You can have a look on the bus company's website: www.alsa.es

Arriving from Granada airport:

Granada airport is very small and has few connections but it is well connected with the city center. There is a bus that connects the city center with the airport some minutes after/before each departure/arrival (www.alsa.es).

Arriving from Madrid airport:

We don't really recommend this option as you'll need to spend a long time on the bus, but it's still an option :)

From Madrid airport you should take the "cercanías" to Mendez Álvaro bus station. From there, you can take a 5h bus to Granada bus station (www.alsa.es). You can also take a train that's faster (www.renfe.com).

GETTING TO THE VENUE

Getting to Pinos Genil from Granada is very simple. It takes only 20 minutes by bus from the city center.

Here you can see where the bus stops and the exact times: The bus is nr 390.

It's possible for you to check-in from 17:30. The first meal we will have is dinner, so please, be in the hotel on the 13th by 20:00.



TRAVEL COSTS

Please, use the <u>distance band calculator</u> to know your budget for the trip

For travel distances between 100 and 499 KM: 180 EUR per participant

For travel distances between 500 and 1999 KM: 275 EUR per participant

For travel distances between 2000 and 2999 KM: 360 EUR per participant

For travel distances between 3000 and 3999 KM: 530 EUR per participant

- Remember to keep all the original tickets for the reimbursement. We can only reimburse the tickets that we get the original receipts and boarding passes from.
- Las Niñas del Tul team should approve the trip before making the purchase. Remember that you have to use the distance band calculator to know the budget you have for your trip
