Invitation

Games and playfulness are the main topics we have been focusing on for two years, thanks to the **Youth for Youth** (LINK) Strategic Partnership, Erasmus+ project. With the **SDGames Training**, we want to keep on playing and promoting the use of games to awaken a participatory spirit to enhance green skills in education via...

- 1) **introducing the GreenComp** as a framework to increase quality in youth work working towards sustainability.
- 2) **exploring the possible applications of games** as empowering tools facilitating inclusive change.
- 3) **promoting action-oriented youth work** and solidarity projects as tangible options to better realize SDGs.

We believe that youth work can be **action-oriented and project-based** and can support values and activities that formal education does not have the capacity.



SDGames

...is a 6-day-long training course designed for active practitioners working with youth either as youth workers, educators, volunteers, or youth leaders to take part in value-driven, youth-centric activities for sustainable actions that allow them to question their views and practices to be able to act as potential agents with hands-on experiences and a better understanding of sustainable concepts in youth work.

Together we will use the Game Development Process (GDP) as an inclusive tool to support quality improvements in youth work and to foster active citizenship initiatives in a broader context.



Planned activities

Day 1 : Getting to know each other and embodying sustainable values

Day 2-3 : From systems thinking to problem framing with SDGs - embracing complexity in sustainability

Day 4-5 : Envisioning a sustainable future via game development - adaptability and explorative thinking in focus

Day 6 : Action Planning for a gameful change - planning next steps, applying the learnt competencies in youth work

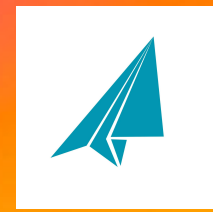
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
