

FROMBARI AIRPORT

There are two chances from Bari Airport: one is by shuttle bus from (timetables <u>here</u>) and another one is by train. In this second case, you need to take the train from the airport (Bari K.W.) to Bari centrale and then from Bari Centrale to Matera (information on this <u>website</u>). To get the train to Matera you need to change the station. They are close to each other, the company is <u>Ferrovie Appulo Lucane</u>).

Project dates are **15-20 April including travel days.**You have to arrive in Matera by 7 p.m. on April 15 and leave in the morning of April 20.







REMERS

I Travel, board and lodging expenses are covered by the European fund. Travel expenses will be reimbursed within the limits of the ceilings as foreseen by the User's Guide of the program Erasmus+ (**distance calculator**) and according to the rules of the Partnership Agreement that will be signed once we confirm the partnership.

Participants can arrive 1 day before and leave 1 day after the project dates. Extra nights will not be covered by the project.

In case of green travel, participants have 2 travel days for the arrivals and other 2 travel days for the departure. We ask you to inform us in advance in case you want to use green travel.

In order to get reimbursement, participants have to provide all the requested travel documents: tickets, invoices, reservations in their name. It will not be possible to reimburse taxi and first class fares.

In the project is aimed at youth workers and people having a pivotal role within youth organizations based in Program Countries (no partner countries, sorry) We will not select participants working as freelance or not being involved in any youth organization. At the application stage it will be necessary to provide partner's OID.
