Context

Viaje a la Sostenibildad (VALS) is an organization based in Zaragoza, Spain. Our central objective is to achieve a society more committed to the values of inclusion, sustainability, and solidarity. We are a social cooperative that works constantly on providing innovative and inspiring opportunities for young people in order to spark their curiosity, encourage them to take a more active role in society, and give them space to develop their own ideas with or without guidance.

Inclusion and diversity play pivotal roles in advancing the principles of sustainability, forming a foundation for resilient and thriving communities. Inclusive practices empower individuals from various backgrounds to actively contribute to sustainable solutions, enhancing community engagement, promoting a sense of belonging and shared responsibility. Sustainability is not just an environmental endeavor; it is a holistic commitment that thrives on the richness of diverse perspectives and inclusive collaborations.

Target group

Organizations active in developing Erasmus+ KA2 small-scale and Cooperation Partnerships, or interested in developing such projects. Staff members of youth organizations and youth workers associated to NGOs. It is possible for more than 1 person to apply per organization (age: 18+).
