DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

The training course, "Zero Addiction," will bring together 18 project managers and drug therapists from 6 countries for an immersive experience designed to provide a comprehensive understanding of effective interventions and approaches within youth drug therapy and social work practices. This program offers a deep dive into the intricate nature of addiction and codependency, empowering participants with the necessary tools and insights to effectively address these complex issues based on the best practices of each participating country. Furthermore, the program serves as an occasion for sharing expertise on online and offline platforms and building new cooperations.

OBJECTIVES



- Explore cultural competence in addressing addiction and codependency within a social work context;
- Understand the complex interplay of biological, psychological, and social factors contributing to addiction and co-dependency;
- Develop proficiency in assessing and identifying signs of addiction and co-dependency within diverse populations;
- Gain new tools, including participants' approaches, for the treatment of addiction and co-dependency, enhancing the ability to provide comprehensive support and referrals for youth dealing with these issues;
- Develop a Toolkit with all the outputs of the training.







Participants are expected to:

- Share insights regarding the methods employed to address youth addiction and codependency within their respective countries as part of their contribution;
- Share case studies from their professional experiences and describe the strategies employed to address them effectively;
- Identify and articulate the challenges encountered in their respective countries regarding addiction treatment.

Objectives:

- Develop a comprehensive platform that includes the techniques, tools, and strategies acquired during the training, making it accessible to all participants;
- Contribute to the advancement of the Moroccan approach to treating addiction and codependency;
- Develop new and future collaborations within the field of social work and youth coaching.









WHERE? LARACHE, MOROCCO

Larache is an important harbour town in the region of Tanger-Tetouan-Al Hoceima in northwestern Morocco.



PROJECT VENUE FOUNDOUK ZELJOU

Foundouk Zeljou is a cultural center where young people gather to prepare for their studies as well as participate in social and cultural activities. All meals will be served in the Zeljou restaurant. And most of the activities will be held in this venue.











HOW TO REACH THE UENUE


Once you arrive at the airport in Morocco with your country team, your transportation will be organized by the host organization. It will take around one hour to get to the venue from the airport of Tangier, and two hours from Rabat airport. Another alternativ would be to takee a bus from malaga to Once you are at the airport, please, contact Anna or Chems (Numbers below). 

Two, three, or four participants of the same gender and from different countries will be sharing the same room in Hotel Chommis, 15 minutes walk from the project venue.






GENERALLY, WHAT TO BRING FOR MOROCCO?



- May will be warm in Morocco, be sure to bring suitable clothes taking into consideration the cultural appreciation of the country, if you have any questions about that, reach out to us;
- A towel, and hygienic products (shampoo, shower gel);
- You can also find ATMs everywhere in Larache, no need to take out money at airport or change before coming to the country;
- At the airport, you can buy a SIM card of either <u>Maroc Telecom</u> or <u>INWI</u> or <u>Orange</u>, and you can charge it with 1GB for 10 MAD (1€);
- Good mood, ideas, and a lot of energy!









Conditions of participation

Participation in the project is free of charge. Meals and accommodation will be covered by the project budget. Travel costs are reimbursed within the maximum reimbursement amounts listed on the right. Make sure that your travel dates are maximum of two days before and after the project takes place for budget wise.

Participants will receive the travel reimbursement via bank transfer within 2 months after the end of the project upon received of all participant's original and scanned copies of their travel documentation, flight receipts indicating prices, and boarding passes of each flight taken.

Once you arrive to Morocco, with your country team, your transportation to/from the airport will be organised by the host organisation without additional charges. It will take around 1 hour to get to Larache from the airport of Tangier. If you come before the 10th or stay after the 18th, transportation costs to and from the airport will be on your charge. We can always help with finding other alternative transportation means.

It is highly recommended to fly in groups since the host organization will only conduct group pick-ups. Make sure to communicate flight reservations with the organizers before booking. We will make a WhatsApp group to facilitate logistical arrangements for the project.





NEXT STEP

Having this info pack means that you are already selected for the project, therefore, we need you to go through the following:

- 1. Fill in this <u>participation form</u> if you did not do it yet;
- 2. Purchase medical insurance that will cover your medical costs in Morocco in case of health issues and accidents (check with your home insurance if it cover travel insurance, most companies do);
- 3. Send your digital travel tickets and medical insurance to ouiam.q@framtidstaget.se
- 4. Keep all receipts, travel tickets and boarding passes to be handed to Ouiam in Larache, just make sure to scan them or take a photograph before handing them;
- 5. Every participant in the project must agree to the rules set in the <u>Declaration of Honour.</u> Therefore, we kindly ask you to read through carefully, and once agreed, fill in, sign and scan and send them to same email above.

- If you have a connecting flight, we recommend that you choose tickets from the same company so that you have insurance in case one of the flights is delayed or cancelled; Better to book flights from their original companies;
- Look for tickets to the Tangier Airport, which is closer to Larache. If there are no flights to Tangier, it is also possible to arrive at Rabat-Sale Airport;
- We reimburse only the most budget tickets available and cover only one extra luggage per country team;
- You can stay up to 2 extra days in Morocco before and after the project. In that case, you will have to cover the costs of accommodation and food for the additional days yourself;
- Please, travel together as a group as it will be easier to arrange transportation to/from the airport.


