## **Objectives of the project**



# Sint Maarten, the Netherlands

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Sint Maarten is an autonomous country within the Kingdom of the Netherlands. The population of Sint Maarten is a little bit more than 43 000 people and the capital is Philipsburg.

The official languages in Sint Maarten are Dutch and English and the official currency is Antillean guilder, but you can also usually pay with USD or EUR.

Divided Island: Sint Maarten is part of the island of Saint Martin, which is divided between two countries. The southern part, Sint Maarten, is a constituent country of the Kingdom of the Netherlands, while the northern part, Saint-Martin, is a French overseas collectivity.

Sint Maarten is known for its cultural diversity, with over 100 different nationalities represented. This blend of cultures is reflected in its languages, food, and festivals, with Dutch, English, and a local Creole being commonly spoken.



# TRAVEL INFORMATION

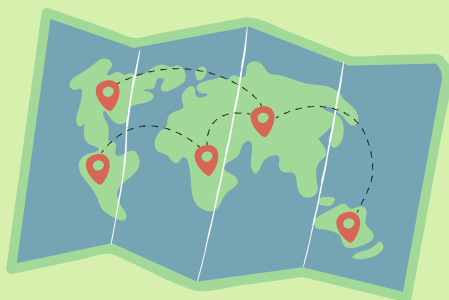
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Reimbursement of travel costs will only be done upon presentation of all (including return tickets) original tickets, receipt/invoices and boarding passes. Please print in advance all documents, which are related to travel expenses. Please do not lose your boarding passes; you will need them for the reimbursement of travel cost.

We can reimburse your travel costs only if you attend all sessions;

**KEEP YOUR BOARDING PASSES**, Collect e-tickets, invoices, and proof of payment. Please consider taking bus or train instead of short distance flights. For the tickets make sure the date, the itinerary, and the price are visible on the ticket. Taxi cannot be reimbursed. Participants must provide all the documents to the organization – we will reimburse the whole group to the team leader or to organization to be distributed to participants accordingly.



# TRAVEL INFORMATION

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Reimbursement will be done in 2 months after each country group member provides all the necessary documents including their return documents and proofs of dissemination. EU citizens do not require a visa to travel to Sint Maarten. Please check with the Embassy of the Kingdom of the Netherlands in your country if you need passport or ID for arrival.

# ACCOMODATION

Paula's country Inn, Peach road 6, South Reward, Sint Maarten

Groups of 3-6 will be split by gender and stay in dormitory rooms with toilets and showers in each room. Bedrooms are equipped with bunk beds.

Please take your towels and shampoo with you. Also, bring any medication that you use. Towels are NOT provided.

The accommodation is quite simple so please don't expect hotel or luxury conditions.

Bedrooms are equipped with bunk beds, warderobes, bathrooms and ACs. There will be a shared kitchen available for use.

This is airbnb place – not a hotel. The cleaning services will not be provided and participants will have to take care about the space and cleanliness.





# IMPORTANT

All participants must have travel and health insurance, what will be covered from the project budget (Partner organizations will organize insurance for their participants).

It is not allowed to come to the training one day later or to leave one day before the designated dates.

Cultural nights can consist of games, presentations, cooking or dances that represent the culture of each partner's home country. Bring some traditional food and drinks, flags, costume or music. Take this into consideration while planning your activity, it shouldn't be more than 60 minutes long.

**Money.** Official currency is the Netherlands Antillean guilder and USD, EUR are widely accepted and used everywhere. Credit and debit cards are accepted on most of the places, but we suggest you to bring at least some cash with you as a backup.

**Food.** The breakfast will be prepared by participants – each day one national team will cook breakfast for all participants, we will supply the products. Lunch and dinner will be provided. If you have any allergies or diets, please, mention that in the participant form.

**No drugs or any illegal things allowed.**

**Plugs.** Sockets support only US type plugs. If you have any US adapters for your chargers, please, don't forget to bring it for your own comfort.

Before arrival to Sint Maarten every participant should be added in the Whatsapp group where we will share any additional important information.






# PACKING LIST

Towels, toiletry, any medication you might need.

Clothes for warmer weather, temperature at this time of the year in Sint Maarten is around 30°C.

All boarding passes, tickets and invoices because we cannot reimburse your trip without that.
