



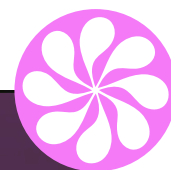

# ABOUT THE PROGRAM



Sustainability Matters is a training course for youth workers and all professionals working with young people. The program aims to enhance understanding of sustainability, enabling participants to discuss and take action on related issues, and fostering a world where resources are used and shared justly. The program will take place in Hollókő, Hungary between 17-25 March 2025.

The training program was designed to support youth workers develop a fresh environmental perspective and explore new methods and tools for initiating a more sustainable lifestyle both personally and professionally. They will also practice how to promote the idea of sustainability and use different tools in their work with youngsters.



## METHODOLOGY

The main method used is creative recycling, which is based on creativity, cooperation and crafting. We employ creativity and upcycling as effective tools for cultivating a variety of skills, supported by additional non-formal learning methods.

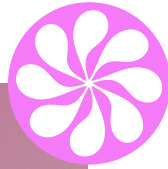
# THE TEAM

# LOGISTICS



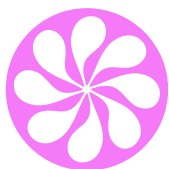
17-25 March, 2024 | Hollókő, Hungary

- Travel cost (according to the conditions of reimbursement - see below)

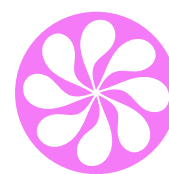

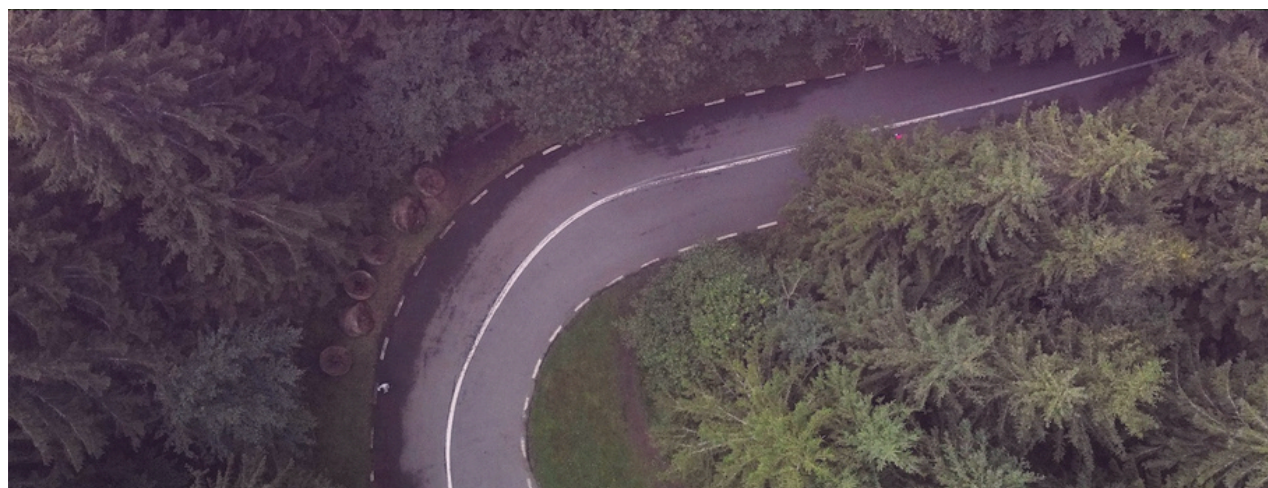
