PROJECT OVERVIEW

"Roots & Routes: Youth Workers Strengthening Communities" is a 7-day training course within the Erasmus+ program, organized by Entropia APS, based in Rende, Calabria, Italy, from March 25 to March 31, 2025.

This project aims to strengthen the skills of **aspiring youth workers**, providing them with essential and innovative tools to tackle the challenges of working with young people by exploring the connection between **local grounding ("Roots")** and **global connections ("Routes")**. The goal is to develop young professionals capable of creating a positive impact in their local communities while maintaining an international and innovative perspective.

Over the course of seven days, participants will explore the topic through a variety of methods, including **interactive workshops**, **pratical exercises and creative sessions**. A dynamic and engaging mix of activities designed to provide skills, innovative tools and meaningful experiences. Participants will engage in role-playing scenarios and World Café-style discussions to explore topics such as social cohesion, inclusion, and global challenges, alongside team-building exercises to foster an informal, collaborative, and inclusive learning environment.

During the training course, there will be opportunities for cultural exchange, informal networking, and personal growth, culminating in the awarding of the Youthpass, the European certificate that recognizes and certifies the skills acquired.

"Roots & Routes" equips participants with the tools to become skilled youth workers ready to strengthen their communities while embracing global opportunities.

Travel expenses, accommodation, and all training facilities are covered by the European Union's Erasmus+ program.



FOOD & ACCOMODATION



Accommodation and food will be provided during the days stated for the training course.

The accomodation will be held in "Residenza Socrates" Address: <u>Via Alberto Savinio, 87036 Quattromiglia (CS), Calabria, Italy</u>

Participants will be hosted in shared rooms and three meals per day (breakfast, lunch and dinner) will be provided.

Check-in must necessarily take place between 3 p.m. and 8 p.m. on Monday 24 March (arrival day) and check-out by 10 a.m. on Tuesday 1 April (departure day).





TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

Before purchasing tickets, please share your travel plans with us! Only travel expenses **shared and approved** by the association will be reimbursed.

We expect your **travel plan** within 7 days after the selection e-mail, otherwise we may consider it as a cancellation of your participation.

After your travel plan has been approved, we kindly ask you to **send us your travel ticket** purchase confirmation in 5 days.



The planned travel days are: 1 for arrival and 1 for departure and they are to be used necessarily for **24th of March and 1st of April.**

Accommodation, food or other for the extra-days is **NOT covered** by the project budget.

In case of **green travel**, participants have 2 travel days for the arrivals and other 2 travel days for the departure.

We ask you to **inform us in advance** in case you want to use green travel.

Only class II or Economy Class tickets are eligible for reimbursement of costs. Taxi and private cars are **not eligible for reimbursement**.

The declaration (provided by our organisation at the end of the project) is accurate, correctly completed and signed.



Keep in mind, the reimbursement **cannot exceed the maximum amount** granted by the program according to the <u>Distance Band Calculator</u>, which you can also consult if you do not know the distance between your city and ours (Rende).

Reimbursement of the travel expenses will be sent to each participant's bank account individually.
