






About the project

We are thrilled to announce the second phase of the **Europe's Musical Interconnection** (EUMI) project, a collaborative training course spearheaded by Youmore NGO and supported by partner organizations from Romania, Türkiye, Germany, France, Portugal, and Spain.



What is our aim?

- 1. Enhance Musical Knowledge: Dive into diverse European musical traditions, leveraging each participant's expertise.
- 2. Cultural Exchange: Share and explore musical traditions from different countries, including contemporary styles.
- 3. Creative Expression: Apply newfound knowledge to personal and professional creative endeavors.
- 4. Theoretical Insights: Gain historical perspectives on cultural interdependence in Europe.
- 5. Practical Tools: Acquire methods to engage youth through music in meaningful ways.
- 6. Cultural Understanding: Discover how music relates to cultural diversity and connection.
- 7. **Rediscover Roots:** Uncover the shared heritage of European nations through music and of course perform all together!

Why attend this course?

The 6-day training will feature engaging activities such as:

Presentations and Workshops:

Learn from experienced trainers and guest musicians.

Group Activities:

Collaborate with peers from different cultural backgrounds.

Exploratory Research:

Delve into the roots and styles of music across Europe.

Dynamic Engagement:

Participate in hands-on activities and discussions about musicology.

Field Visit:

Experience the rich history of music at Val Camonica, at Central Alps of Italy.

By the end of the course, participants will:

- Gain creative skills to foster youth engagement through music.
- Develop strategies to connect with young people from diverse backgrounds.

Prepare to implement effective, music-based activities in their communities.



Methodology

We will use the non-formal education methodology which willfacilitate the development and acquisition of new skills, competences and attitudes.

The course will combine a wide range of methods coming from practice, team building, interactivity, and cooperation.

It will be based on experiential learning. Participants will come from artistic background.

The course will be eminently practical but brief inputs will set the framework in different moments across the learning process.

There will be flexibility to adapt to the needs of the group and their motivations, within reasonable limits.














The venue

The project will be hosted in **Centro Vacanze Concarena**


Participants will be accommodated in rooms of 6 - 8 persons.

Instructions for Selected Participants

- 1. Notification of Selection: If you receive a notification about being selected to participate, please follow the instructions outlined in the next slides.
- 2. Confirmation Deadline: After the 9th of February 2025, all selected participants must confirm their participation by sending their travel plans to the Hosting NGO including the musical instrument.
- 3. Travel Plan Approval:
 - Travel plans must be approved by the Hosting NGO to ensure reimbursement.
 - Any unapproved travel plans will not be eligible for reimbursement.
- 4. Travel Window:
 - Selected participants may travel up to 2 days before or 2 days after the training dates.
 - Please note that the costs for the extra 2 nights' stay will be at your own expense.

Ensure you comply with these guidelines to secure your participation and reimbursement eligibility.

Conditions

To be entitled for reimbursement you must:

- Take a Musical instrument with you
- Take part at least to the 80% of the project activities
- Follow the travel instructions
- Execute tasks assigned to participants, including dissemination tasks.
- Follow basic rules of coexistence and respect of the instructions.

Travel costs will be reimbursed through a bank transfer after delivering invoices / tickets.

Participation fee is already deducted from travel costs.
