





# About Eskişehir

Eskişehir (pronounced [es'kiʃehir]; Turkish: eski"old", şehir"city") is a city in northwestern Turkey and the capital of the Eskişehir Province. According to the 2011 census, the population of the city is 648,396. The city is located on the banks of the Porsuk River, 792 m above sea level, where it overlooks the fertile Phrygian Valley. In the nearby hills one can find hot springs. The city is 233 km (145 mi) to the west of Ankara, 330 km (205 mi) to the southeast of Istanbul and 78 km (48 mi) to the northeast of Kütahya. Known as a university town, both Eskişehir Osmangazi University and Anadolu University (which has one of the largest student enrollments in the world) are based in Eskişehir. The province covers an area of 2,678 km<sup>2</sup> (1,034 sqmi).

# How to Reach Eskişehir



- It is on mid-west Anatolia.
- By bus (about 7 hours) or fast train it is about 3 hours from Istanbul & 2,5 hours from Ankara.
- Istanbul is recommended as a transfer location since there is a direct metro line from Ataturk Airport to the Bus Station and fast train line is very close to Sabiha Gökçen Airport. However, Ankara is also a convenient since there is a direct transportation to Bus & Train stations.
- Further information will be provided on transportation for the selected participants.

# About the TC: Participant profile

*Who should participate?*

People who;

- are motivated , likes teamwork, enjoys participation, are responsible.
- aims positive impact on society by the enterprises they have joint / are going to join with the motivation of getting know new cultures.
- have the passion for understanding the components of enterprises.
- are active youth workers who want to increase their level of skills about entrepreneurship and who has the experience of youth work at least about 1 year. (included managers, active members, leaders, project managers, project leaders, responsables, board members etc.)
- has enough speaking level of English to easily participate to debates, brainstorming, working groups, presentations etc. during the project.

*This is a Training Course! It contains several sessions & workshops on topics related with the core subjects and It has more intense agenda than any YouthExchange.*

# About the TC: Participant Tasks/Missions

There are some tasks/missions expected from participants before/after the activity. These are;

## *Before Activity:*

- Making research about **Youth Unemployment** in their local/national levels. (What are the main causes, what are the numbers etc.)
- Short / Middle term solution proposals about the **youth unemployment** problem.
- Participants will create 5-10 minutes presentations about the topics above.

## *After Activity:*

- As a part of disseminating and exploitation of the results process, creating and presenting a presentation (in considered of the whole project) to minimum 20 young people per participant.

## Further Details:

- The training course will take place in Eskişehir, Turkey between 2<sup>nd</sup> of August and 9<sup>th</sup> of August 2018. The arrivals and first meeting will be on 2<sup>nd</sup> of August.
- The Project Includes 11 Countries: Greece, Italy, Lithuania, Moldova, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Spain, Turkey and Ukraine.
- There will be 3 participants selected from each country.
- Main priorities for the selection are: Reason of applying, motivation, past experience in related field, learning goals and dissemination goals.
- Gender balance will also be one of the priorities of the selection.

## Further Details:

- Accommodation: Will provided for free during the activity.
- Program: Will start on 2<sup>nd</sup> of August evening and end on 9<sup>th</sup> of August evening.
- Venue: All the TC will take place at the same location.
- Food & Coffee Breaks: We will cover 3 meals & 2 coffee breaks per day.
- Transportation: The expenses for transportation will be covered according Erasmus+ Program distance calculator.
- Reimbursement: The reimbursements will be done after we receive all documents of transportation: Flight/Bus/Train/Metro tickets & receipts.
- Limits Per Each Country Per Person: Greece (275€), Italy (275€), Lithuania (275€), Moldova (275€), Poland (275€), Portugal (530€), Romania (275€), Slovakia (275€), Spain (360€), Ukraine (275€), Turkey(0€).
