As an institution managed entirely by young people our mission is to ensure that the youth of our country have the same potential as their peers at the international level.

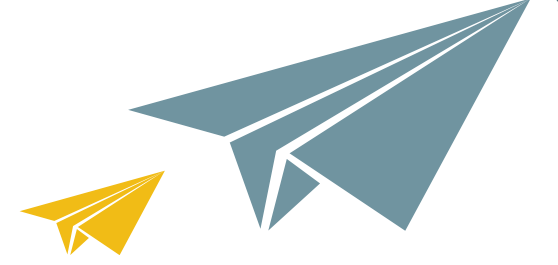
Adapting ourselves to be respectful to

Our Vision

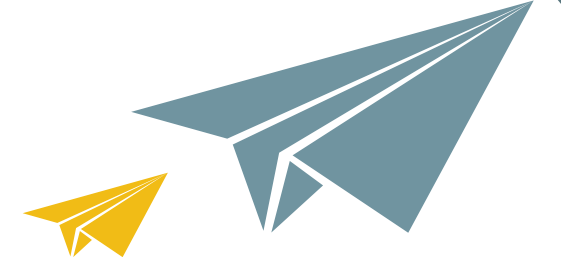


To reach the position of the most competent civilian movement which represents Turkey's youth in the leading role in the international arena.

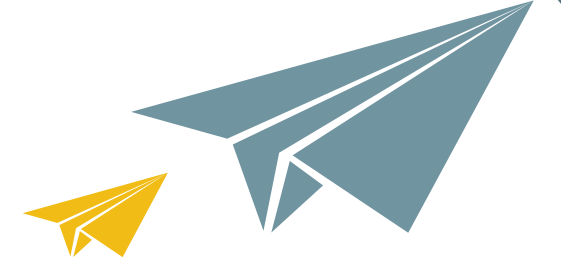
Civil Life Association owned the United Nations ECOSOC consultative status in 2017.

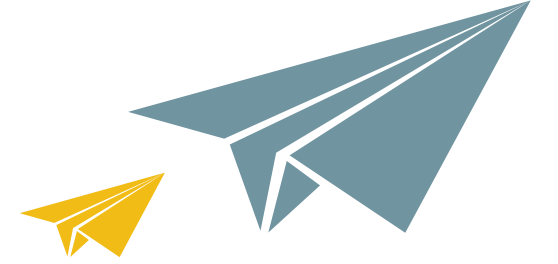

- *Creates safe space for disadvantaged groups and prevents discrimination by social inclusion*

Employment and Entrepreneurship

- *Improves strategies that will reduce unemployment in youth*
- *Creates better career consulting/occupational guidance systems*





Youth Health

- *Guides young people to be leaders in health field*
- *Protects youth from addiction and educates them about how addiction damages physical and mental health*
- *Aims for an active youth group by encouraging them to be more sportive*



- *Creates a communal living culture*
- *Continues national and regional traditions by spreading*
- *Improves young people's capacity in intercultural education and communication*

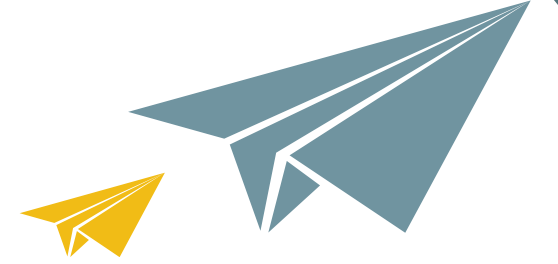


Democratic Participation
