Activities of Eastern Theatre implemented in 2022 attracted around 2000 spectators and participants.

In 2022 we co-organized:

- 2 festivals,
- 2 international projects,
- 1 theatre production 'Republic of Dreams', premiere 16.12.2022 in 'Chatka Żaka', Lublin



In 2023 Eastern Theatre is organizer and partner in projects implemented in 4 regions of Poland:

- Lublin region (Lublin, Bełżyce, Chełm, Kransystaw),
- Mazovia (Warszawa),
- Lesser Poland region (Poronin),
- Upper Silesia (Bytom).



In 2023 Eastern Theatre is leader or partner of 15 international projects - international exchanges of artists or young people talented in arts as well as training courses for educators and artists involved in social-art projects. The activities abroad were implemented in Germany, Italy, Austria, Finland, Spain, Croatia.

Eastern Theatre was the leader of 4 projects hosted in Lublin, Bytom and Poronin.

All the international activities involved 100 participants from Poland - artists, youth, students and volunteers.
