KulturLife has carried out numerous projects on a European level in the past years and has gained different focuses and expertise in the following areas:

Due to its activity across various educational youth sectors, KulturLife regularly develops educational formats, where the gap between formal and non-formal education can be bridged, and which aim at being inclusive for young people from diverse societal, cultural and economical backgrounds.
