What are the activities and experience of the organisation in the areas relevant for this application?

In 2017, Gori Municipality Development and Tana and Tedzami Protected Landscape Management Agency obtained the EVS accreditation as the host organisation and from March 2019 to March 2020, we implemented a volunteering project, named: Youth Development through Education (Project number: 2018-2-IT03-KA125-014377) and hosted two Italian volunteers for 12 months. The overall goal of the project was to promote non-formal learning processes of youth, particularly of who living in rural areas of Gori Municipality in order to improve their key lifelong competencies to become active and successful citizens and increase their employability.

The agency carries out trainings, workshops for young people and supports them to participate in different programs; We have years' of experience in planning and implementing various youth exchange programs.

In 2020, we obtained a European Solidarity Corps Quality Label with the roles of supporting and hosting till 31/12/2027. From May 2021 to April 2022 with our Italian partner organization, we had been implementing European Solidarity Corps volunteering project, named: Yes, Youth Can: Building a Culture of Youth Engagement in Gori Municipality and Rural Areas (Project number: 2020-1-IT03-ESC11-018381). Under this project, we hosted two volunteers from Italy. The volunteers alongside the employees of the agency had been planning, organizing and implementing various activities based on needs of youth living in Gori Municipality.

In 2023, nowadays, with the German organization we are implementing European Solidarity Corps project, named: "Discover the Caucasus" (Project number: 2022-1-DE04-ESC51-VT J-000061805) in Gori Municipality. Under this projects, we are hosting two volunteers from German. Objectives of the project include to enhance the competences of youth workers and young community leaders to empower young people to actively engage in processes of community development in Gori Municipality.

What are the skills and expertise of key staff/persons involved in this application?	The whole staff of the organization has a long experience in international cooperation and project management. Staff members have experience in the participation and implementation of the various Erasmus + projects and activities. Currently, there are two volunteers in the organisation and two staff members are designated as there task-related persons who work with the volunteers and help them in carrying out their daily tasks. During this process, the task-related persons are also improving their competences and are getting more aware of volunteering projects and non-formal education activities. Furthermore, the deputy director of the agency coordinates the whole process of the volunteering project and supports the implementation of the activities organised by the volunteers and their task-related persons. Mr. Giorgi Edisherashvili – head of organisation – has several years of experience in working on the projects manager's position. He has been involved in various Youth in Action and Erasmus + projects as a participant, organizer and project proposal developer.
