D. BACKGROUND AND EXPERIENCE

Our story tracks back in 2012, during the memorandum period in which Greece -our country- was suffering the consequences of austerity, with our main purpose to deal with the humanitarian and economic crisis in Greece.

All this period, many solidarity initiatives and solidarity structures had emerged, such as, social clinics and pharmacies, solidarity schools, without middlemen markets, social cuisines, food distribution grassroots, social cooperatives, collectives. Our initiative has supported these solidarity initiatives and grassroots, not only by trying to create a network between them and increasing the visibility of the solidarity movement so it could be more accessible to people who are in need and those who want to get involved, but creating nationwide campaigns, for medicine and health supplies, school supplies, and food distributions, also.

In view of our long journey, some indicative examples of actions and campaigns for food, medical items, cloths, shoes, financial support, and dissemination of issues worth mentioning:

- Campaign and visit to the much-afflicted Kompani (2014)
- Campaign "A bottle of olive oil for every unemployed" (2014)
- Campaign "Education for All" (2014,2015,2016)
- Campaign with certain Municipalities' Public schools and schoolchildren in Athens for children refugees called "Take my hand" (2016)
- Contributing to the court costs for the condemnation of "Golden Dawn" (through the seven years period trial)
- Covering legal costs for changing the identity details of our transgender fellow citizens, in collaboration with the Transgender Support Association (2018)
- Campaign for supporting the workers in Manolada (2014,2021)
- Campaigns for Refugees' Camps at Moria and Kara-Tepe/Mytilene (from 2016, till 2021)
- Campaign for the Nagorno-Karabach- Artchach war victims (2021)
- Campaign supporting the National Health System in Palestine (2021)
- Campaign to support the Roma families of the deceased Sabanis and little Olga (2021)
- Campaign for the flood victims in Karditsa and central Evia and the fire-affected ones in Evia, Gortynia, Fokida, Olympia, Evros (2020, 2021)
- Participation to the ECI Campaign RIGHT2CURE make anti-pandemic vaccines and treatments a global public good, freely accessible to everyone (2021)

Through all these actions, we have managed to respond very quickly to any unanticipated crisis, for instance, during the big "refugee wave" in 2015, COVID-19 pandemic and the lockdowns, campaigns to support art workers in 2020, concerts for peace in Ukraine, raise awareness among young people about peacebuilding and conflict resolution campaigns for the climate crisis affected supporting youth detention facilities, etc, always with the help of other grassroots and initiatives where youngsters and "young at heart" people are participating.

Due to these facts and with our collaboration with youngsters all these years we would like to pass on all this experience, by creating space and opportunities where they can develop themselves according to their needs, educate themselves in non-formal methods, be an active part of a community especially when any kind of crisis emerges, be in solidarity without any discrimination, with respect on diversity of others and the 17 Goals of Sustainable Development of the United Nations.

- Promote and dissemination of the values in volunteerism and solidarity.
- Be an active part of a community.
- Learn how to raise awareness of an issue and/or a crisis.
- Enhance quality and recognition of youth work and non-formal education in Greece.

What are the activities and experience of the organization in the areas relevant for this application?

Since 2012, as individuals and as an initiative, who were already involved in the solidarity movement throughout more than a decade, we have managed to apply our experience in the field, we have participated in a series of projects in local and international context, enhancing our skills and competencies, facing new different kind of challenges which empowered us and gave us the confidence to face any kind of situation or crisis with the help of others, standing in solidarity with the people in need.

The main goal of our activities is to create space and opportunities not only for every young person, but with people of any age also, to express and develop themselves according to their needs, with respect to diversity, and the 17 Goals of Sustainable Development of the United Nations.

We are working with people of any age, but our focus the last few years are youngsters from 17 till 35 years old, residing in Athens, Greece, but we would like to expand ourselves in other areas in Greece where

we have collaborating initiatives and grassroots. Most of these youngsters are members of low income and social excluded families, possessing an immigrant or refugee background mainly. One of our goals right now is to spread the benefits of the Erasmus+ program, taking part in projects which involve learning, participating, create new methodologies, etc. trying to empower them with useful skills and competencies which will reintegrate them into society, boost their self-esteem, their future employability chances and most importantly the sense of communality that is important for us.

What are the skills and expertise of key staff/persons involved in this application?

Michalis Ydraios (President/Coordinator)

He has a degree in History and Sociology Studies, with specialization in Modern European History (Minsk State University) and he has a post-graduate degree in History (Ionian University). He is fluent in Russian - certified translator of the Greek Ministry of foreign affairs- and speaks English as well. He is an active member of the Civil Society from the 90s and always involved in raising awareness in matters that has to do with Greece, social excluded and discriminated people, climate change democracy, European politics, etc. He is in the solidarity movement from its beginning, as well as in Solidarity for All and he has been holding the position of coordinator since 2017. He was the Vice President from 2019 until 2023 and now he is the President of the organisation. He is also member of the Panhellenic Coordination against the Russian invasion in Ukraine, the Solidarity movement to the Kurdish and Turkish People, the Initiative for the Protection of the Green in the 6th district of the Municipality of Athens and Stop Rearm Europe.

Melina Zikou (Contact Person)

She has a degree in Hospitality Business studies (University of Thessaly) and she is fluent in English. As an active member of the Civil Society, she is in the solidarity movement for over a decade and has joined Solidarity for All in 2015.
