About the project

We want to make a positive impact on the world of student councils.

Student councils in many European countries often face significant challenges in their operations. These challenges include insufficient powers, lack of funding, and inadequate institutional support. As a result, there is limited student participation in decision-making processes within schools, and a weaker influence on the school environment. Additionally, there are significant disparities in the legal status and effectiveness of student councils across different countries, leading to unequal quality of student representation. The project idea will be submitted to the Human Resource Development Center, the Bulgarian National Agency coordinating the Erasmus+ program, under Key Action Partnerships for Cooperation in the field of youth, with a lump sum of 400,000 euros.

The Benefit:

The project will enhance the legal status and functioning of student councils by providing them with the necessary tools and knowledge to perform their roles more effectively. This will lead to better representation of students' interests, increased youth participation in democratic processes, and the strengthening of democratic values among students. Furthermore, the project will encourage collaboration between student councils from different countries, leading to the exchange of best practices and mutual support.

Solutions

The project offers several key solutions to the identified problems:

- Strengthening the legal status and powers of student councils: The project will encourage dialogue with governmental institutions to push for legislative changes that provide student councils with more authority and autonomy. This will enable the councils to have a stronger influence on school decisions and more effectively represent students' interests.
- Providing funding and resources: The project will work to secure adequate funding for student council activities through participation in European programs and national initiatives. This will allow councils to implement larger and more effective projects that benefit students.
- Creating a platform for sharing best practices: The project envisions the creation of an online platform that connects student councils from different countries. This platform will facilitate the exchange of experiences, sharing of successful practices, and promote collaboration among councils.
- Training and capacity-building academies: The project will organize training sessions and academies for student council members to develop their leadership skills and decision-making abilities. This will enable councils to be more effective and have a greater impact on school life.
