





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Our mission and objectives

Youth Social Entrepreneurship

Ford Impulsando Sueños is a free socio-educational project that empowers young people and educates facilitators. Young people aged 14 to 18 become Agents of Change by learning to devise transformative projects, while educators are trained as Facilitators of this process.





Educational Excellence and Leadership

Oportunidad al Talento is a three-year program, from the 4th year of ESO to the 2nd year of Bachillerato (ages 15-18), which offers educational excellence and leadership for social change. With scholarships covering 100% of the costs, it combines equality and excellence, supporting young people with less socioeconomic opportunities. It has been recognized with the European University Foundation and Santander Universities Social Commitment Award in 2020, and was a finalist in the "la Caixa" Foundation Awards for Social Innovation in 2022.

European Voluntary Service (EVS)

The European Voluntary Service (EVS), AIPC Pandora was a Local Contact Point, in Spain, for the European Solidarity Corps (ESC) program through which they offered young people an all-expenses-paid stay of up to one year in a host organization in a European country to promote values such as solidarity, responsibility, justice and sustainability.
